e) Qayqayt path adjacent to field

The proposed development has been approved with an effective MUP connecting Cunningham to the Royal Ave MUP. We will continue to watch to ensure what was designed is actually what gets built.

Unofficial responses received from HUB Office. Garey to connect with Jonathan Mak and confirm what available options we have to distribute the results.
