8) Bike BC funding

a. Surrey

i. 100 Avenue to Tynehead Drive

A two-block extension between 170 and 172 streets.

ii. 164 Street between 84 and 88 Avenues

Full road treatment with 2 traffic lanes including bike lanes.

b. White Rock

No applications are known at this time.

9) Joint ride

It was discussed to have a joint ride between the O-5-O White Rock Cycling Club, the Cross-Canada Cycling Touring Society and HUB Surrey-White Rock along a proposed nieghbourhood bike route along 28 Avenue corridor from Northcrest Drive east to 176 St, a distance of 7.7 km. There can be a possible extension west to 128 Street.
