Make Truck Sideguards Mandatory Now

Truck sideguards prevent cyclists and pedestrians from fatal injuries resulting from being pulled under large trucks, usually when turning. Sadly, this has happened too many times already. Europe has had sideguards mandatory for years now. Canada needs to catch up! Olivia Chow has pushed this in the federal government, and received the **support of the VACC.**

Not only will this increase cyclist and pedestrian safety, it also increases fuel efficiency by over 5% at a conservative estimate.


