- 1. Protected bike lanes on River Parkway from Gilbert to Cambie Rds
- 2. MUP re-build on Westminster Hwy from Nelson Rd to No. 7 Rd
- 3. Odlin Rd Bike Route (No. 3 Rd to almost Hwy 99) [part of Gap 604!]
- 4. Midtown Bikeway (Off-Gilbert) south of Francis
- 5. Parkside Bikeway from Garden City Park-Westminster Hwy (except the gate)
- 6. Crosstown Bikeway intersection upgrade at No. 3 and Lucas Rds
- 7. MUP on Cambie Road from River to No. 3 Rds.
