- 1. Welcome & introductions
- 2. Adoption of January minutes
- 3. HUB Langley Chair, Mitch Nurse, reached out to Rick Bomhof, Director of Engineering and Kyle Ford, Infrastructure Engineer with the City of Langley to learn of any new cycling infrastructure projects. Our City Engineering contacts were able to provide information on two important projects that will be of great benefit to Langley cyclists.
- a) The Glover Road project is currently undergoing a re-design and construction will begin in summer 2021. The re-design includes a cycle track from Fraser Highway to Eastleigh Crescent. There will be separated bike lanes with planters between the vehicle travel lanes and the bike lanes from Eastleigh Crescent to Langley Bypass. HUB Langley will review the plans and offer feedback. Of special concern will be cycling infrastructure at intersections along Glover Road.
- b) The **208 Street** project from 52a Street to Fraser Highway / Langley Bypass will include widened sidewalks on the bridge to a 3.3 meter MUP standard as well as sidewalk extensions north of the existing bike route. The intersection at Fraser Highway and Langley Bypass / 208 Street will have painted improvements. Construction can begin in summer 2021 after additional funding arrives from Translink.
- 4. Mitch reached out to Langley Township Manager of Engineering, Paul Cordeiro to obtain updates on upcoming projects. Paul was open to sharing information and asked Tammy Liu, Engineering Technologist II and key contact for cycling, pedestrian and transit planning to forward a list of current projects.

- a) North Langley Connector Phase 1 Shared Roadways on Glover Rd from 88 Ave to Mavis Ave, Shared Roadways on Mavis Ave from Glover Rd to River Rd and Bicycle Accessible Shoulders on River Rd from Mavis Ave to 240 St
- b) North Langley Connector Phase 2 Bicycle Accessible Shoulders on 248 St from Fraser Hwy to 72 Ave, a MUP on one side of 248 St from 54 Ave to 58A Ave, Shared Roadways on Telegraph Trail from 72 Ave to 80 Ave and a MUP on the north side of 80 Ave from Telegraph Trail to 240 St
- c) 201 St Connector A MUP on the east side of 201 St from Langley Lane Greenway to 100A Ave
- d) 198 St Sidewalk Improvement A MUP on the east side of 198 St from 92A Ave to 96 Ave
- e) 96 Ave Sidewalk Phase 2 Bike lanes on both sides of 96 Ave from Trattle St to Edal St.
- f) Fraser Highway, 24600 to 25000 Block, MUP's due to property limitations (ALR)
- g) Willowbrook Connector from 64 Ave to 68 Ave MUP's and protected bike lanes
- h) 216 St from Telegraph to 88 Ave MUP's due to property restrictions (existing development on west side and school on east side)
- i) 202 St fronting LEC and Schools, west side Extension of MUP's in interim, ultimate MUP's and cycling lanes
- j) 56 Ave from Nicomekl bridge to 213A Street MUP on north side (restriction in property and red coded watercourse on south side)

Future large capital projects, subject to funding in future years currently under design include:

- a) 96 Ave Connector A MUP on the north side of 96 Ave from 198A St to 201 St
- b) 208 St (68 to 76 Ave, and 76 Ave to 84 Ave) MUP's and protected bike lanes.
- c) 212 Connector from 208 St to 77A Ave MUPs and protected bike lanes
- d) 96 Ave from 204 to 208 St MUP's (property constraints both sides)
- 5. Tony contacted Impact Canopies in Port Coquitlam for a quote on 2 feather banners for indoor and outdoor use at HUB related events. Each unit will cost \$184.80 with taxes included. This committee will purchase 2 banners.
- 6. Tony volunteered to distribute the new Translink bike maps to local cycling stores.
- Committee members were urged to attend the virtual HUB Awards Event on February 22 from 5 – 6 pm. Word has it there will be Langley winners.
