

# Vancouver Slow Streets Sept – Dec: Traffic Calming Upgrades




# CoV Transportation Demand Management Plan

- At a high level:
  - Focused on promotion and enabling (education, encouragement, incentives) to encourage the use of sustainable transportation
  - 5-year view
  - Includes plans for promoting active school travel
  - Coordination with other departments (including Park Board) to ensure TDM principles are considered





# CoV Cycling Map – Fall 2020 Update






# **Regional Bikeway Map**
