
Strava Metro Example heat map – 2019/2020




To do:






Proposed 16th Ave Bikeway Improvements near UBC







Prototype Gap Maps with SoC Route Data








- MUP connecting United Blvd to Argyle (blue stars)

- Uses existing bridge at Coquitlam river (narrow sidewalk, red star)



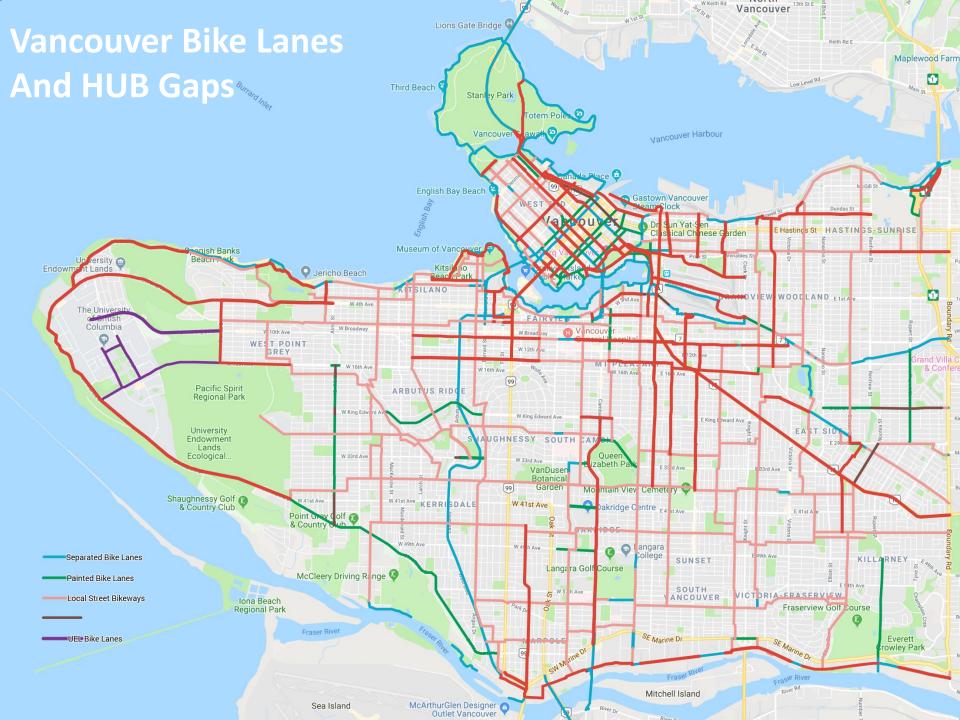



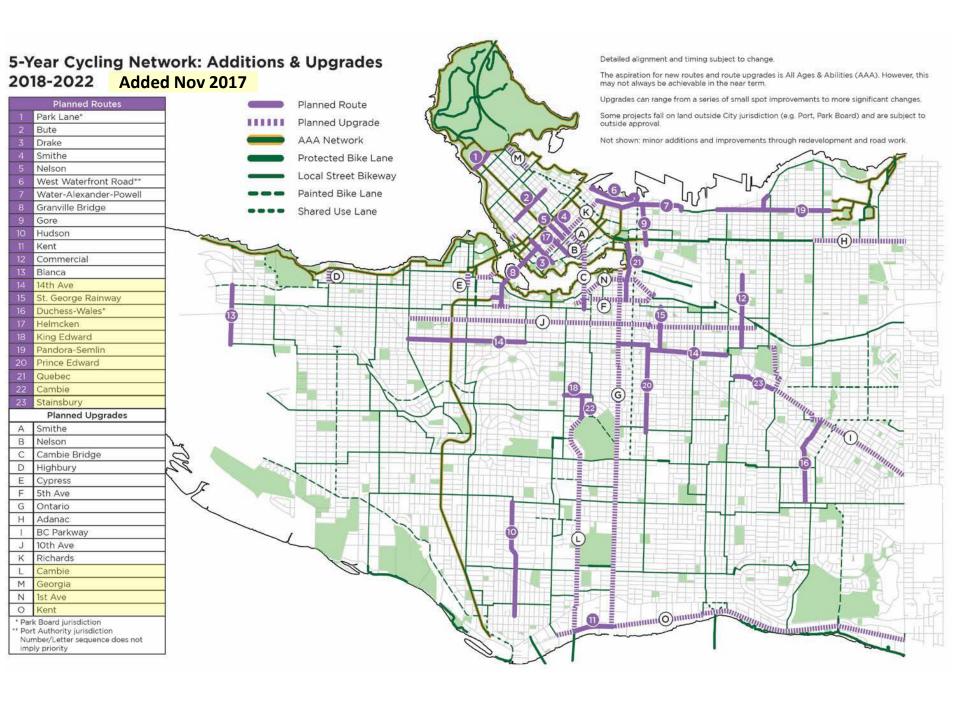





Prototype Gap Maps with SoC Route Data




Regional Bikeway Map
