2. Review & Approval of Minutes from November 22 2022. Moved by Sarah, seconded by John
3. Old Business
 - a. Langley City - no updates
 - b. Langley Township
 - i. noted that Councillor Van Popta's Notice of Motion re the 96th Ave bollards was withdrawn at recent council meeting.

ACTION ITEM - Sarah and Zack to review agendas for Township and City council meetings (respectively) for items of interest to the committee, to circulate items of interest before each meeting.

- ii. Glover Road overpass - Geraldine and John attended the info session and provided feedback on the planning boards including request to separate bike traffic from pedestrians
 - iii. 40th Avenue - John provided an update on his follow up with engineering but received no productive response. He will follow up on further comment re the Master Transportation Plan current in development.
4. New Business
 - a. Vision Zero grant for \$20,000 available, due January 23, 2023. Not enough time to apply for this but suggested we work on a generic grant application to be ready for next time. Jonathan noted that HUB had submitted two applications.

- b. Volunteer and Infrastructure awards - request for suggested nominees. Agreed that we nominate the Glover Road bike lanes in Langley City.
- c. John discussed the Cross Canada Cycle Tour Society. As part of his work with them he will be attending HUB Surrey meetings and will identify common gaps and connectivity issues.
- d. John shared an article re a new electric kick-scooter pilot in the Township. Jonathan to check official HUB position and recommendations.
- e. Rejean provided an update on his bicentennial bike trail project, T'sai. He has been working with City and Township mayors. Goal is to close the loop in 2024. He will keep us updated.
- f. Strategies for 2023 - John suggested rolling forward our 2022 goals

- a. Reminder from John that the budget process is under way and there is opportunity to for public input. He has emailed the clerk regarding timing and will advise on timing and process.
