1. Welcome & Introductions.

2. Review & Approval of Minutes from January 18, 2023. Moved by Rejean, seconded by Mitch

### 3. Old Business

- a. Langley City
  - Developing a AAA bidirectional bike lane on Michaud Crescent eventually to join with Glover. Included in the capital budget for 2023
  - ii. On Fraser Hwy, they are moving barriers from the outside to the inside of the bike lanes (i.e. between bikes and traffic)
  - iii. New bicyclists will be permitted in bus only lanes. New signs are being added after Zach's request to the mayor.

#### b. Langley Township

- i. Glover Road and 232nd St overpasses Geraldine circulated a letter to MoTI and the response regarding MUPs that was disappointing. She is working with Jonathan on a response.
- ii. Budget items Geraldine will draft a letter to council supporting budget for cycling tiems
- iii. 40th Avenue some photos from John were shared.
- iv. Cycling Improvement Fund was discussed we will keep an on this motion as it progresses.
- c. Rejean provided an update regarding the T'sai project including an upcoming meeting with Mayor Pachal and a de-coupling from the bicentennial due to



concerns about links to colonization. There will be an open house in Surrey in April to view Phase I of the plan.

d. Zach will look for opportunities to provide feedback to Translink regarding active transportation links to the new Skytrain route.

### 4. New Business

- a. HUB Langley action plan we reviewed the 2022 action plan and will continue in a similar vein for the coming year.
  - i. Bike Parking (including the motion noted above)
  - ii. Engagement with TOL regarding overpasses in the area
  - iii. Engagement with the general public through local media (e.g. letters to the paper)
- b. Bike to School/Bike to Work week. Scheduled for May 29 to June 4. Mitch explained the support provided by HUB. Geraldine would like to get all elementary schools in the Langleys participating. She will also look into the logistics and funding associated with linking a study to observing participation.
