Assessment Rides (Jeff, Anthony)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assessment rides are reviews of existing or potential bike routes within the City of Vancouver (CoV). Reports are generated and posted on our wiki. Our reports are used to advocate with municipal officials and provide them with recommendations. • No assessment rides are planned this month. 	
Cycling in Parks (Lisa)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Update on the Stanley Park Mobility Study. We met with Park Board staff for a review of their progress on this study. An update report (with no vote) is being presented to PB Commissioners at their meeting on November 27th. Meetings are available to watch online • The Metro Vancouver water supply tunnel project in Stanley Park was discussed. 	
Arbutus Greenway (Stan)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The proposed design of the 41st Ave intersection on the Arbutus Greenway was discussed. In addition to crossing improvements at 41st, and vehicle turning restrictions, the Arbutus Greenway is being widened and physical separation added between the walking and cycling paths, between 40th and 42nd streets. 	
Broadway Subway (Jeff and Anthony)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction updates are being received from the project office and published through our social media feeds. 	
East Van Greenway (Clark)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No update this month 	
Municipal Election (Lisa)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The elections group is creating a scorecard for elected officials 	

9. Consultations

- The [Imagine West End Waterfront](#) draft concept plan was reviewed. The protected bikeway along Beach Ave is planned to be retained, but may be moved into the park, to allow the doubling of vehicle travel lanes, and bidirectional vehicle travel, between Denman and Stanley Park. This would increase vehicle volumes along Beach Ave. More details in the presentation, including slides of the plan details.
- As part of the [Broadway Public Realm](#) plan, CoV staff are considering active transportation connections to Granville and Cambie subway stations.
- Strathcona Traffic Calming update received from CoV staff.
- Vehicle Parking Minimums removed for the West End and Broadway Plan areas.
- Grants from the BC Government for additional funds for the Granville Connector and Drake St Bikeway were applied for. Council also directed staff to report back on funding for the Kent Ave Bikeway improvements by the end of Q2 2024.
- We attended a Translink CEO roundtable on Active Transportation with Kevin Quinn
