Meeting Minutes

- 1. Welcome & Introductions
- 2. Review & Approval of Minutes from May 24, 2023.
 - a. Minutes approved subject to adjustment in wording regarding the bike parking discussion in City of Langley. Sarah will update before uploading.

- a. Langley City update
 - i. New bike lane being installed between 203 St. and Glover Road
- b. Langley Township update

John has had an update regarding the Transportation Master Plan. Public consultation is to begin in September/October of this year. HUB has not been consulted with other stakeholders and will only have the opportunity to comment with the public.

4. New Business

- a. Bike Jam July 8 LEPS is looking for someone to do minor adjustments or tuneups. No one at the meeting can help, Sarah will circulate to members to see if anyone can help.
- b. Ungap the Map MoTI (Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure) would like to have the gaps in the lower mainland on MoTI routes identified. In Langley this would be 200th St., Glover Road, 264th St., Fraser Hwy. Sarah will take a look at these and respond to HUB in the next week.
- c. 264th St. overpass update meeting to be held in the next month. Sarah has been invited.
- d. 40th Avenue John did a speed study with his own radar device on May 26
 between 8 and 9 am. He noted 972 vehicles with speeds ranging from 43 kmh to
 95 kmh (the section he tested was a 60 kmh zone). He calculated an average of



64 kmh but noted that 251 vehicles were going 70 or over, 30 were going 80 or over, and 4 were going faster than 90 kmh. John is planning to test at another day and time, and then would like to put the information together into a form that will convey the issues in this section of road.
