Updates from Working Groups				
Assessment Rides (Jeff)	 Assessment rides are reviews of existing or potential bike routes within the City of Vancouver (CoV). Reports are generated and posted on our wiki. Strathcona report is being reviewed by the Strathcona BIA and finalized. Ride on Pender Corridor (Hornby to Stanley Park) is pending. Iron Workers Memorial Bridge next on the list. MOTI approached about upgrading access at south end. 	Jeff, Anthony, Clark and Stan: Schedule rides, or complete ride reports as noted above.		
Seaside South (Lisa)	 Scope is the Seawall from Olympic Village through to the improved Seaside Greenway along Pt Grey Rd. Currently focusing on the section from Burrard Bridge, around Vanier Park, through Haddon Park, Kits Beach Park to Trafalgar. The route is now an official project with City Engineering! Timelines and details to be confirmed. Lisa, Anthony and Jeff meeting with City and Park Board staff next week for further details. 			
Arbutus Greenway (Stan)	 Former railway line from the Fraser River through to 1st Ave at Granville Island. Easy grade through some very scenic areas with easy access to shops and services. The City has hired a consultant for the permanent path. Design Jam was well organized, with different stakeholders well represented, and overall quite successful. High level of engagement with the community. Final plans expected in Spring 2018. Broadway and 12th crossings are still ongoing. Marine Drive crossing upgrade scheduled for Q1 2018. 			
Broadway Subway (Anthony)	 Working group looking at the extension of the SkyTrain from VCC Clark to Arbutus St. Currently in planning stages. TransLink projects construction will start in 2019. Mayors Council assembled to assess community impact. Working group being established, and Anthony is our representative on this committee. HUB is concerned about the impact of construction on nearby bike routes. 			


6. City Consultations (Jeff)

- Highlights this month:
 - Cambie Bridge Bike Lane Separated bike lane southbound on the Cambie Bridge to alleviate congestion on the bike/pedestrian path on the east side of the Cambie Bridge. Vehicle traffic is

- not currently limited by lanes on the bridge, but by lights at each end. Open House Nov 30th at 511 W Broadway at Cambie; details here. Online survey will be available shortly, or send an email to cambiebridge@vancouver.ca indicating your support.
- Georgia Gateway West (Entrance to Vancouver from the Lions Gate Bridge) Project to make Georgia St (Stanley Park causeway to Nicola near Pender) a more complete street. Online survey here. It is critical that this section link to connections in Stanley Park, and east of Nicola (our Powell Corridor gap).

7. City Five Year Plan for Cycling Upgrades (Jeff)

- Jeff presented on City Infrastructure Additions & Upgrades, pointing out the new and improved bike routes proposed for the City. Most new and upgraded routes will be AAA. Additions this month are highlighted in yellow.



- City Council has received this report; however significant projects will still go to City Council for approval at the time of design and construction.
