Old Business

Tony checked out some infrastructure upgrades in Langley Township near St. Andrews Church as well as on Glover Road in front of Value Village.

- 4.A. Tony and Mitch met with Arthur, Lisa, and Alexis from HUB to discuss bike education programs. Tony suggested to invite Arthur to the DPAC meeting so he could present the bike education programs. Arthur mentioned a liability issue with the bike train we did last year at JKE. It might be best to discuss biking to school with parents and encourage them to bike to school with their kids rather than have HUB committee members organize and run the bike trains.
- 4.B. Tony will meet with JKE PAC on March 1st and DPAC in April to discuss Bike to School Week.
- 4.C. Geraldine will discuss BTSW with Fine Arts School and WGSS.
- 4.D. 40 Ave Murray Creek. As a follow-up to John's letter of 2018, John and Tony prepared a detailed report regarding the lack of safe cycling infrastructure on 40 Ave. Tony will send it to ToL engineering and council.
- 4.E. Tony will send in the committee action plan to HUB.

Federal funding is currently available for active transportation improvements. Deadline is March 31st and Tony will ask the Township if they are aware of the funding. John recommended the purchasing of bike racks for Township properties. Tony will also forward the funding information to Langley City.

- 4.F. Tony brought up the fact that there are lots of potholes around the Township. He contacted the Township through the website for potholes on 96th in Fort Langley and they were repaired relatively quickly. Mitch will include a link to the service request on the HUB Langley Facebook page.
- 4.G. 216th St corridor study. Tony spoke about the new entrance proposed at Ecole des Voyageurs and how dangerous it could be considering the speed vehicles travel on 88th Ave. The topic will be discussed more next month when Geraldine is present.

Committee Dinner – Tony will look into buying a gift card at Adrian's and submit the receipt to HUB before the fiscal year ends.

HUB sent the committee a list of current HUB members in Langley and there are 22 people on the list. John suggested we invite them all to the next committee meeting to see if they are interested in getting involved with the committee.
