**Introductions**

**Meeting Topics:**

1. Discussion of Volunteer and Administrative roles in HUB – Neil Pope Chair, Roel Schootman Co-Chair and HUB Regional Advisory Committee(RAC) Rep, Sandra Jones Secretary, Hilary Cole Minute Taker
2. It was decided that members who attend external meetings with stakeholders will not only report back verbally at the following meeting, but also in brief written form aka bullets.
3. Position of bike rack currently in storage was discussed. The Boundary Bay trail access at 12<sup>th</sup> Ave and Beach Grove Road was agreed as a place to follow up on with Hon Yee at the City of Delta, specifically the triangle area in the parking lot which no cars currently use.
4. An agenda item added by a member regarding the path from the US border to 12<sup>th</sup> Ave by Southlands. John and Carol are to contact Southlands project manager.
5. Although no motion was made, it was decided to send a formal letter to TransLink written by the Chair and Secretary regarding HUB's safety concerns around the Westham Island Bridge deck that is undergoing repair work in 2018/2019, Patrick will provide the last email correspondence that detailed our requests.
6. Project 529 bike registry launched by the Delta Police, Friday, October 19<sup>th</sup> at the North Delta Sungod Recreation Centre from 10am – 6 pm. All members are invited. Details sent in a news events bulletin.

**Committee Reports:**

1. Chair, Co-Chair and Secretary attended a meeting with the City of Delta Engineering Department, Sept 12. Discussed were:
  - the status of Delta road upgrade projects that include new or improved bike facilities, and most of the items on our HUB Cycling Delta Priority List (Sept 2018). The City has this report in hand and is shared with members at [bikehub.ca/delta](http://bikehub.ca/delta).Discussion:
  - Federal and provincial share funding is applied for by the City
  - 8A bike lane upgrade
  - 52 St bike lanes in Tsawwassen
  - New TAC rules for bike lane width and bike facility type - changes to volume and speed criteria
  - 28 Ave construction between 52 St and 56 St – flaggers
  - Signage on 64 St at Hwy 17 (was rectified by City within the week)
  - 72 St memorial
  - Intersection sightline safety throughout Delta
  - Bike shuttle drop-off map provision
  - 56 St /12 Ave intersection design with green bike box
  - 53A St and 16 Ave intersection
  - Off-road (verge) access by SM Products to Wellington Point Park from end of dike top trail
  - Need TFN routes / updated Delta routes on the Delta bike map
  - Cycling provision at roundabouts (ref. Boundary Bay Rd)
