 - Delta Engineering asked Neil to set up ride route through South Delta to review possible cycling safety improvements and possible new cycling infrastructure. A

- Neil and Roel will be on the ride: planned attendance Steven Lan (engineering),
 Todd Stewardson (deputy director of Parks and Rec), Melanie Kerr (Director of finance), others
- Neil has given them a written list and map with recommendations
- Neil will follow up with decision-makers on Transportation Plan updates during ride
- Will ask about funding for education
- Paul: would like to see HUB have a position on bike lanes in door zone
 - Jonathan to find out HUB's position on this kind of infrastructure
- e. Ladner West Dyke Culvert Plan
 - Neil reported there is possibility that a culvert will be added to allow better access to the north end of the Ladner West Dyke.
