#### 1. Welcome & Introductions

## 3. Items for Discussion

- Debrief on June incident HUB staff (Navdeep)
  - Sue reached out to HUB staff previously with a complaint about bullying/harassment
  - HUB took this complaint very seriously and reached out to her with several options to talk about this privately (call, text, email), with many time spots available.
  - Sue was uncooperative and instead emailed a large number of people which is inappropriate
  - HUB has told her that a public setting is not a fair setting to discuss this
  - Jonathan & Navdeep have done a significant investigation and briefed the board president, with the conclusion that no harassment has occurred.

- Update on RATC (Derek/Jesse)
  - 2023-07-12 Social event with RATC at O'Hare pub
  - Nathan brought along a copy of the cycling network plan, which can also be found here:

- For the most part the city is going to be following the established plan; anything additional needs to be added on a year-by-year basis
- Nathan mentioned he's taking a vacation to Copenhagen soon, but will be keeping an eye out for infrastructure

- Traffic control group mostly cares about car flow; we need to convince them to consider pedestrian flow as well
- Derek recently talked to Lloyd Bie (director of transportation) and got the impression that the city wants us to provide feedback -> more assessment rides?
- Update on Great Blue Heron Way (Sheryl)
  - She and Elder Ruth went to White Rock open house discussing Nicomekl Waterfront park, hoping to link a few transportation methods together (bus loop & cycling connections)
    - They want to encourage cycling but are hung up with CN rail
  - Need to contact HUB Surrey to investigate gaps, deal with Mud Bay to Crescent Beach route, since that's in Surrey
- Update on council meetings (Sheryl)
  - Council was removing 60km/hr speed limits a while back; they have been all removed.
  - Cameras are being installed in various places in conjunction with ICBC & the province
    - Cameras likely doing multiple roles (speeding, red light, accident recording, triggering traffic signals)
- Rosewood Manor open house
  - There's paths for multiple modes of transportation
  - Sheryl commented that on No. 2 rd they'll need good safety measures
  - There will be bike lockers in all buildings
- On-demand bike lockers at Brighouse Station Issues: offline often, dirty, sketchy? (Amy)
  - Amy 2 / 3 times she's used them, they were sketchy (dirty clothes inside, IKEA bags, urine, lock wouldn't engage because someone jammed rebar into the locking mechanism)
  - Out of 16 lockers on site, the app shows 11, of which 8 are offline
  - After reaching out to Translink, Translink responded quickly; in summary they're aware of the problem, vandalism at the Bridgeport Station has been unprecedented
  - <u>HUB, in conjunction with Translink, prepared a survey for recommending new</u> <u>stations</u>
  - HUB has connections with Translink and can escalate these concerns Amy to get in touch with <u>evan.hammer@bikehub.ca</u>

- Donna had dropped by and didn't notice any issues, aside from the lockers being dented. Maybe they were cleaned up before Donna dropped by
- Bike parking (Amy?)
  - Hasn't had a chance to look into it, but would like to explore it in the future
  - Vancouver has a program where businesses can request that the city install bike parking
  - Notably, the City can't do anything on private property except write a letter; City can only install parking on e.g. public sidewalks.
    - Need to show to business that people want to come by bike
  - Donna mentioned her school has leftover bike racks, which could be free to be installed

- Shell Rd Assessment Ride
  - Report slowly being filled out, see here
- Steveston & Railway affordable homes (Jesse)
  - There's an affordable housing project being built at Railway Ave (next to Railway Greenway) & Steveston Hwy (next to upcoming Steveston MUP)
  - It's going to council this Monday 2023-07-17 item no. 2, 4831 Steveston Hwy, full report here
