Bus Rapid Transit Stakeholder recommendations

<u>Bus Rapid TransLink</u> It's a dedicated bus lane on major roads. In Surrey its on the King George Boulevard for 23KM. It would go from Guildford Mall to White Rock. <u>24: Action - Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Routes - Local Committee Collaboration - Google Docs</u>

Committee Recommendations in order of prioritization:

- Protected cycle lanes constructed along King George from the BC Parkway at University Drive to White Rock
- Construction of multi-use path connection at 80 Avenue across creek to 137 A Street
- extension of protected cycle lanes from King George to creek bridge
- Extension of 70B Avenue protected cycle lanes to 138 Street.
- Extension of multi-use path on 144 Street to 100 Avenue
- Protected cycle lanes on 150 Street from 105 Avenue to 100 Avenue
- Protected cycle lanes on 148 Street from 105 Avenue to 100 Avenue
- Protected cycle lanes on 140 Street from 105 Avenue to 100 Avenue
- Pay per day use bike steel lockers (like Carvolth Exchange) at the stations or at every 2nd station
 Bike share station (or floating bike home locations near BRT stations)
