# 3. Advocacy Issues/Opportunities (Stephen)

- River Road- RCMP Report from Community Safety Committee Meeting
  - Link to report <u>here</u> (begins CS 50, HUB Richmond referenced on CS-54 & 55)

Summary of report:

- RCMP enforcement confirmed that this section of River Road is notorious for speeding (365 speeding tickets issues, representing 15% of all speeding tickets issued in the city)
- 2. RCMP to install two additional speed reading boards.
- 3. RCMP confirmed that increased enforcement has *not* led to reduced speeding and therefore "traffic calming and speed limiting features" are recommended.

*HUB Richmond Action:* Monitor further updates from City. Consider writing follow-up letter report to re-state HUB Cycling's positions.
