a. Langley City / Langley Township - Nothing to report

4. New Business

- a. Amanda Smith invited HUB Langley to have an information station at the Langley Farmers Market which is at the Derek Doubleday Arboretum. Amanda's goal is to encourage more people to ride their bikes to the Farmer's Market. At this time there are no bike racks on the property. During their time at the venue, HUB members will track the number of bikes that arrive and talk to market visitors about secure end of trip bike parking. The 3 days selected for our participation will be June 22, July 20 and August 17 from 3-7pm.
- b. Paul Cordeiro responded to our 40 Avenue report on March 28. In the near term, ToL will examine the current condition and possibly do sidewalk repairs and vegetation trimming. Speed reader boards may be considered. The Murray Creek culvert will see some upgrading this summer. Longterm improvements will likely be minimal. Paul did note that ToL is undertaking the development of a new Transportation and Mobility Strategy in 2022. The process will take approximately 2 years. This will include an update of the 2015 Cycling Plan. HUB will be able to provide input.

- c. Langley,Surrey committees and HUB staffer Evan Hammer attended a preliminary Surrey / Langley Skytrain meeting April 11 which was hosted by Translink. The objective was to give us a general overview of the project. Given the early planning stage, the team was not able to respond to our specific questions at this time. We will have opportunities at future stakeholder meetings to provide input. Areas of concern will be safe cycling access to stations, secure bike parking, elevators that can accommodate bikes, train cars that can accommodate multiple bikes, protected bike lanes on the greenway and bike friendly intersections.
- d. It was decided that HUB Langley will not participate in the Pedal Poll Survey June 6-12, 2022.
- e. 2022 municipal elections: Committee members will meet with select incumbent councillors and candidates to discuss active transportation issues in Langley. Mayoral candidates will be invited to a HUB meeting for a frank discussion of the slow progress being made on cylcing infrastructure.
- f. Langley City has provided us with an application form to have a celebration station at city hall for a four hour period during Go By Bike Week.
- g. The 2nd edition of the regional cycling maps has been printed and copies will be delivered to local committees soon. We will distribute the maps to all Langley and Aldergrove bike stores as we did in 2021.
