4.1 ATAC PM - no update.

4.5 June 11 - CEED Centre Block Party

Michael and Jackie manned our booth.

Michael felt the event was not so effective. Not too many visitors from general public. Talked mostly to people from other booths.

12 visitors were shown photos of bike boxes and elephant feet. 10/11 people were drivers, 9 were cyclists.

Out of 12 people, 3 people knew what a bike box was, 9 people did not know. Only one person knew what an elephant feet crossing was, while 11 people did not.
