The HUB Cycling, Burnaby Local Committee is writing to request that additional Bikeep secured bike lockers with mobile app access be installed at SkyTrain stations in Burnaby. The Local Committee would recommend the following stations: Metrotown, Brentwood, Lougheed, Edmonds, and Patterson. As frequent commuters, we have noticed that there is a growing demand for secure and convenient bike parking at the stations, especially with the increasing popularity of cycling as a mode of transportation.

The Local Committee understands that TransLink is currently providing trial lockers with mobile app access at other SkyTrain stations and transit exchanges in Metro Vancouver. These lockers have been proven to be successful in enhancing the user experience and improving the security of bike parking. They provide a high level of protection against theft and damage and are much more secure than bike racks and the current bike parkades.

Installing additional Bikeep bike lockers with mobile app access at SkyTrain stations in Burnaby would be of great benefit to the community. They would encourage more people to use their bikes for transportation, help to reduce traffic congestion, and promote a more sustainable and healthy lifestyle.
