We are writing to express our strong support for the City's proposal for a cost-sharing application to provide a route which runs along Lougheed Ave., starting at the Sharpe St/Chilko Dr. intersection and continuing to the Coquitlam Central Exchange.

The improved MUP on the west side of Lougheed Hwy. will address existing constraints and poor pavement conditions. It will be more comfortable for both cyclists and pedestrians. The MUP and on-street cycling facilities on Sharpe St. will provide safer access to Meadowbrook Elementary School.

The completion of this project will add to an ongoing effort to provide an AAA Class 1 facility which will run along the Lougheed corridor and help improve Active Transportation options to and from the Coquitlam Central Exchange, as well as Meadowbrook Elementary School.
