1. Welcome & introductions
2. Minutes from April 2020 were reviewed and approved.
3. HUB Cycling Surrey has responded to Mitch regarding the 53 Avenue connector from Langley to KPU Cloverdale. Their intent is to get Surrey and Langley to collaborate on this important cycling corridor.
4. In lieu of Bike to Work Week, HUB is promoting Go by Bike Week May 25-31. Cyclists are encouraged go online for more information and to register at [bikehub.ca](http://bikehub.ca). This event is for people who ride for pleasure and those who commute. Mitch has registered our committee as a team. Members can sign-up with the team at [bikehub.ca](http://bikehub.ca).
5. The HUB 20 in 20 Infrastructure Challenge will take place this year. HUB has sent invitations to Langley City and Langley Township. Langley City did not participate last year.
6. HUB hosted an online forum May 6 to discuss road reallocation during the pandemic. Mitch, Sarah H and Geraldine took part in the discussion. HUB Committees have been encouraging their local governments to address road reallocation.
7. HUB circulated a petition in April to gather support for road reallocation in Metro Vancouver. Over 2600 signatures were collected throughout the region by the deadline date. Geraldine and Sarah Hill invested considerable time and effort in communications with both Langleys. To date, Langley City is considering two locations for reallocation. Geraldine and Sarah will provide feedback at the next meeting.
8. Mitch announced that HUB is considering an online all-committee workshop.
