

## HUB Langley Meeting Minutes – May 15, 2017

1. Meeting called to order at 19:00 hours.
2. Welcome and introductions.
3. Minutes of February 2017 adopted.
4. Dan stated he has submitted the application for renewing the meeting room rental at the Township's Civic Facility.
5. Dan sent an email to Kyle Ford at Langley City Engineering to address issues regarding intersections and signage on 56 Ave.
6. There are three light poles in the middle of the bike path on 203rd St. Dan will contact Langley City to address the issue.
7. Stan spoke about the ride to Victoria that he and Dan had done the previous week. They rode the Lochside Trail and the new separated cycle track on Pandora Ave. They shared pictures and described the pros and cons of the new infrastructure. Sounded like a great trip.
8. Dan spoke with Raphael at MEC Langley regarding Bikefest and insurance. Last year there was an issue with insurance and Dan didn't want the same thing to happen this year so he discussed it with Raphael to sort it out.
9. Tony will put out advertisements at elementary schools for Bikefest and info will be sent out through DPAC.
10. Dan reached out to Langley Produce Market to inquire about providing fruit or food to Bikefest. They are willing and able to support. MEC will provide tables, chairs, and a tent. We are anticipating 3 groups of 20 kids to be put through the course.

8. Infrastructure tours - Dan and Tony met with Mayor Froese to discuss acquiring a bus as transport for the infrastructure tours. They met with Translink today (May 15) and they agreed to provide a 33-35 seat bus. Dan gave an overview of the infrastructure tour. The bus will be available from 9:30 am - 2:30 pm. Stan will inquire about food sponsorship from local grocery stores. Dan will inquire about booking a room at Surrey City Hall.

9. Bike to Work Week - Dan gave an overview of BTWW. The Langley, Surrey, and Maple Ridge committees will jointly man a station at the Golden Ears Bridge from 4-6 pm. Volunteers are asked to arrive at 3:30 pm. Tony, Stan, and Geraldine can commit. Michelle from Fraser Health will also be helping out.
