1. Meeting called to order at 19:00.

The committee members will brainstorm on the format of the article and email back and forth to come up with an outline. With the municipal election complete this would, hopefully, bring cycling to the table amongst the council. The committee would then follow up with a delegation to council to further reinforce the importance of building a safe connected network of bike infrastructure.
8. There was a general discussion on the upcoming election with members speaking about individual candidates and where they stand on certain issues.

9. Bike To Work Week - The committee agreed that we should have a celebration station for the upcoming BTWW from Oct 29 - Nov 4. It was decided that it would take place at Carvolth Exchange pending Translink's approval (Tony to follow up).
