

TriCities HUB Committee Minutes,

Date: 2 October, 2013

1. Safety:

Discussion on safety advocacy. Who is the target audience? Commuters or recreational riders? Answer: more gains can be made educating casual recreational riders. Safety events in TriCities: 2012 Port Moody safety fair was a good venue for us. Lots of contact with the public. We were not invited this year. Action John S: find out who is in charge.

Canada day events have become very large particularly in Coquitlam.

Action: investigate possibility of a booth at next year's Canada day event in Coquitlam.

Safety classes through HUB? Is HUB main office involved in safety education issues in Coquitlam. As a sponsor they may require it.

Action: find out if there is an education aspect to HUB's sponsorship arrangement with Coquitlam.

Signage improvements? There are locations where signage needs to be improved, particularly the Lougheed bike lane at Brunette.

Action: Simon will submit service request.

Safety issue: Concrete barrier westbound on Lougheed at United. Action: David D will submit service request to Coquitlam.

Action: Simon to look into possibility of obtaining a go pro camera for the local committee for documenting safety issues (Q is this an eligible expense?).

2. Advocacy items for upcoming year

Pitt river bridge: need to arrange site visit with ministry (action: Simon)

Como Creek bridge at Fraser Mills site: find out when it is planned (action Simon)

Pitt River road: Submit service request to move barriers back from shoulder (action Jack T)

Port Moody bike routes. Action for next meeting: Andrew will contact PM to see what is going on with bike lanes. Are there any new developments with Skytrain?

3. Assessment rides: Agreed to aim for an assessment ride Oct 12 or 13. Target: Lougheed bike lanes including Brunette and Lougheed. Also check out new bike lane on United Blvd. Simon will send out reminder weather permitting.
