Re: Meeting Mark Halpin with HUB Committee Dec. 3, 2020

Hi Mark,

Thanks again for hosting the Zoom meeting with David Pollock and Erin, Jenny and myself on Dec. 3. It was nice to meet you!

As promised, I've attached our gap list. The list of course continues to be a work in progress, and presently only shows the more significant gaps in the cycling network. More will be added in the coming months, and we will periodically send you updated lists and maps. The attached map is not entirely updated from the list, but gives a good impression of where the most important gaps are from the perspective of All Ages All Abilities cycling.

As you can see our top priorities right now are:

- the missing link between the two sections of MUP on Hwy 7 (220 to 216)*,
- separated shared facilities on Hwy 7 between 266 and 287 Street.**
- * As Erin mentioned during the meeting, it's important to not just provide fixes here and there as opportunies arise, but to actually connect the fixes to make a more complete route. Having short segments of high quality facilities with nothing to connect them eventually erodes public support for continued investment in cycling. If there's anything our Committee can do to advance this particular gap on Council's agenda, please let us know.
- ** It absolutely makes sense to include separated shared facilities in MoTl's widening project (if not now, then when?)...Highway 7 is part of TransLink's MBN and also part of Metro Vancouver's Greenways 2050 plan. The 2 meter wide shoulder that's presently being proposed by MoTl most definitely does not conform to the Province's own guidelines (BCATDG) and is obviously a very unsafe place to be for anyone not in a motor vehicle. The tragic death of Daphne Toumbanakis this past July is testament to that. Would be awesome if the City could support HUB's efforts (as has TransLink). Not only Lougheed Highway is an important cycling link through Maple Ridge and to other municipalities to the east and west, but also the Haney Bypass, and it's important that the City supports these corridors as important local and regional cycling routes, and communicates that support clearly and consistently across plans, maps and correspondence to MoTl so that they incorporate this into planning of infrastructure under their jurisdiction.

The attached State of Cycling map shows the existing designated bike routes as they have been assessed by HUB/TransLink: green = comfortable for most yellow = comfortable for some orange = comfortable for few red = comfortable for very few

purple lines = gaps according to our gap list.

Mark, it would be great if in the new year you could present to our committee on the process for updating the Transportation Plan. We meet every 2nd Thursday of the month at 7 pm. The first few months of 2021, our meetings will be on Jan. 14, Feb. 11 and March 11. Please let us know which date will be good for you so we can add it to the agenda for that meeting and send you the Zoom link when available.

Perhaps you can give some thought as to how our committee can be of assistance. We'll be very happy to provide man (and woman!-) power and -brains once again if the City is open to our input.

I would like to ask two more things at this point:

- 1) We mentioned the problem with inconsistency of the 2014 maps. Can we safely assume that any missing street segments will be included in the new Multi-modal Transportation Map for the Town Centre, as they are in the cycling network map in the 2014 Transportation Plan? E.g.
 - The Haney Bypass
 - Lougheed Highway east of 227 Street and west of 116 Ave.
 - Lougheed Highway west of 222 Street
 - 224 Street between Brown Ave. and North Ave
- 2) You mentioned during the meeting that you were surprised by the amount of traffic on Kanaka Way. It's actually not so surprising, because there's **a lot** of development going on east of where I live. Every few years over the past 10+ years I've been asking when we can expect bike lanes. I know that (in ~ 2017?) cycling infra consultant Richard Drdul was consulted by the City on the design for 240th and Kanaka Way. I would love to know what his recommendation was. Could you let me know? And any idea when improvements along Kanaka Way can be expected?

Actually, 3 things: Feel free to give us a shout any time you want to go for a ride in Maple Ridge to check things out and you'd like some insights of locals like us. We'd love to ride along! My husband Ivan (HUB co-chair) will be happy to lend you his bike if you need one.

We'd love to go for a ride with more engineering staff members once the weather is a bit more pleasant.
