Group wants to know why MUP is proposed; many driveways along this route and group feels that MUP is not the safest way to go due to this. Question raised by group; Is this because the city wants to secure a grant for cycle infrastructure to put towards the cost of sidewalk building on this road? Where is funding for this coming from? Jenny will take these questions to next ATAC meeting as well as ask about timeline.

Also in the conceptual planning stage; 2 way MUP on the south side of Hammond Road between 203rd and West Coast Express Station.
