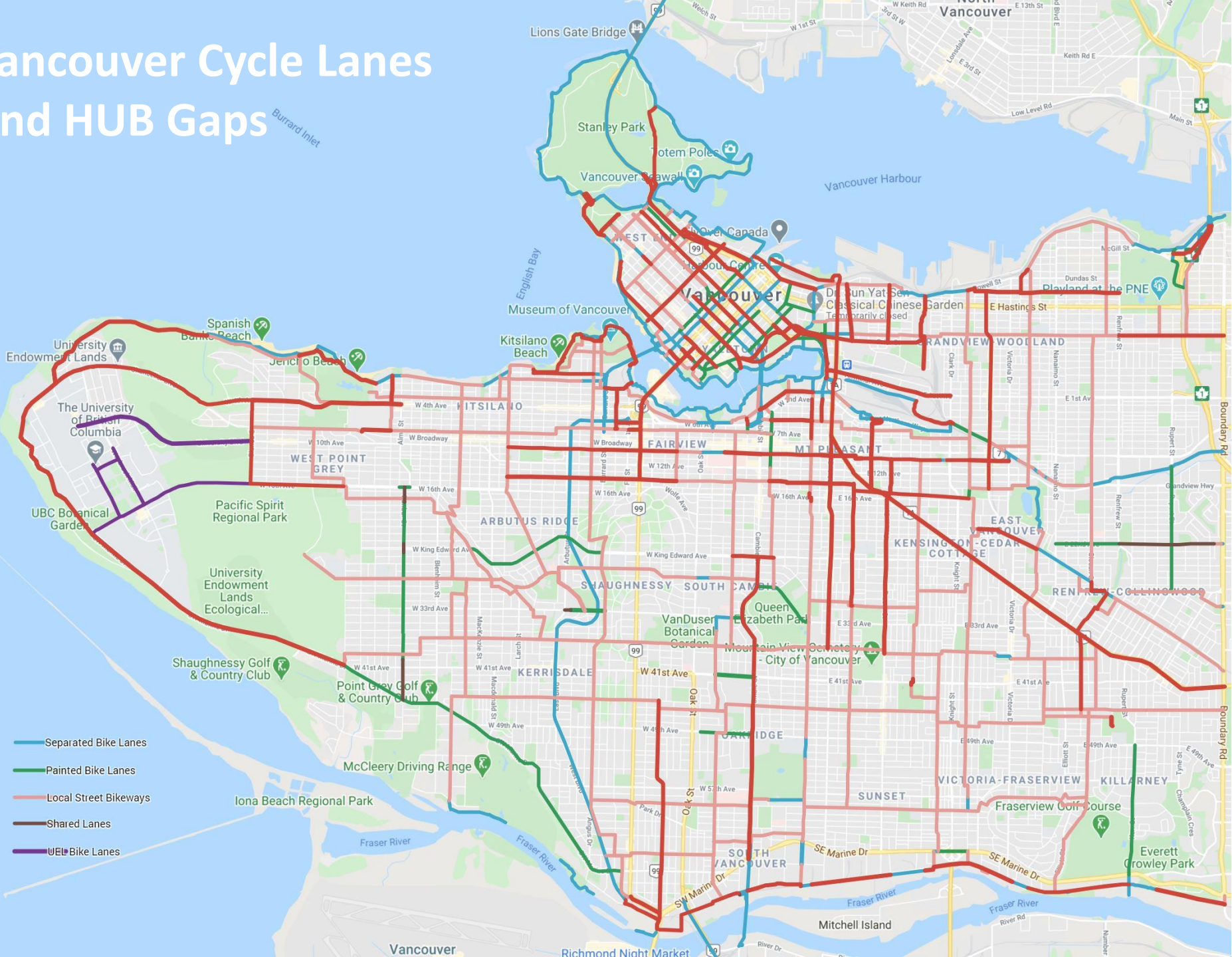

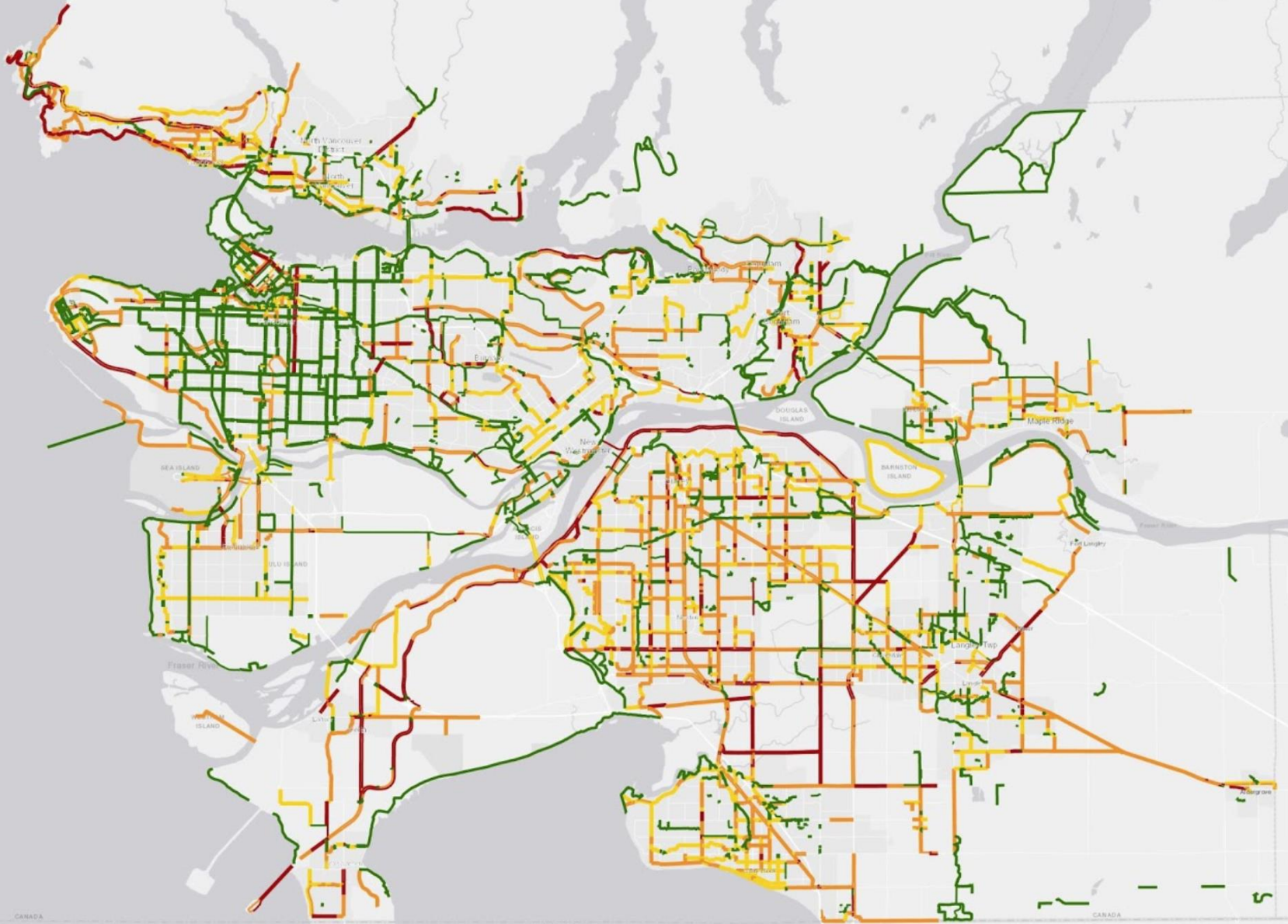

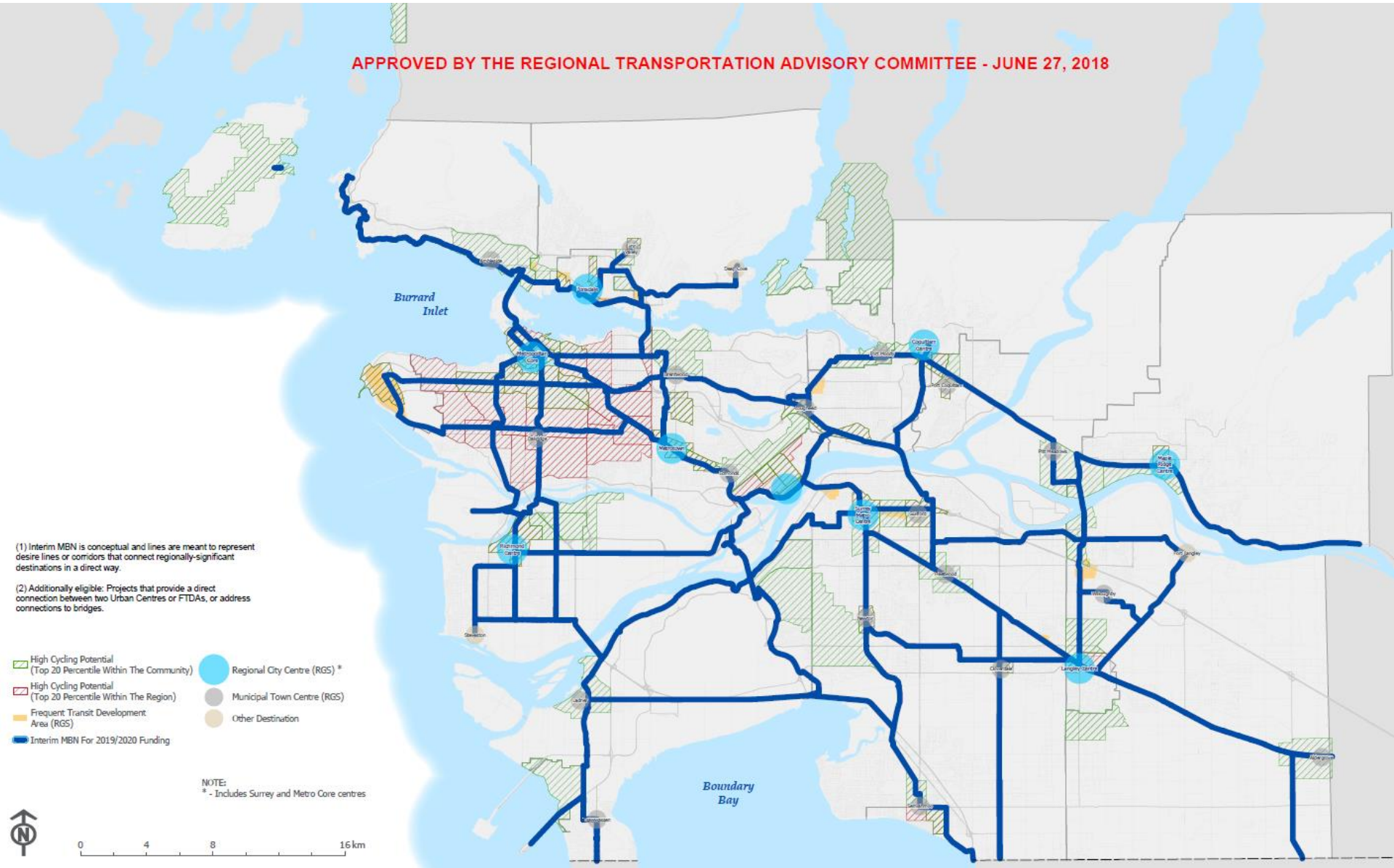

  - Gaps that have been identified recently, through the CoV Slow Streets and Room to Move initiatives

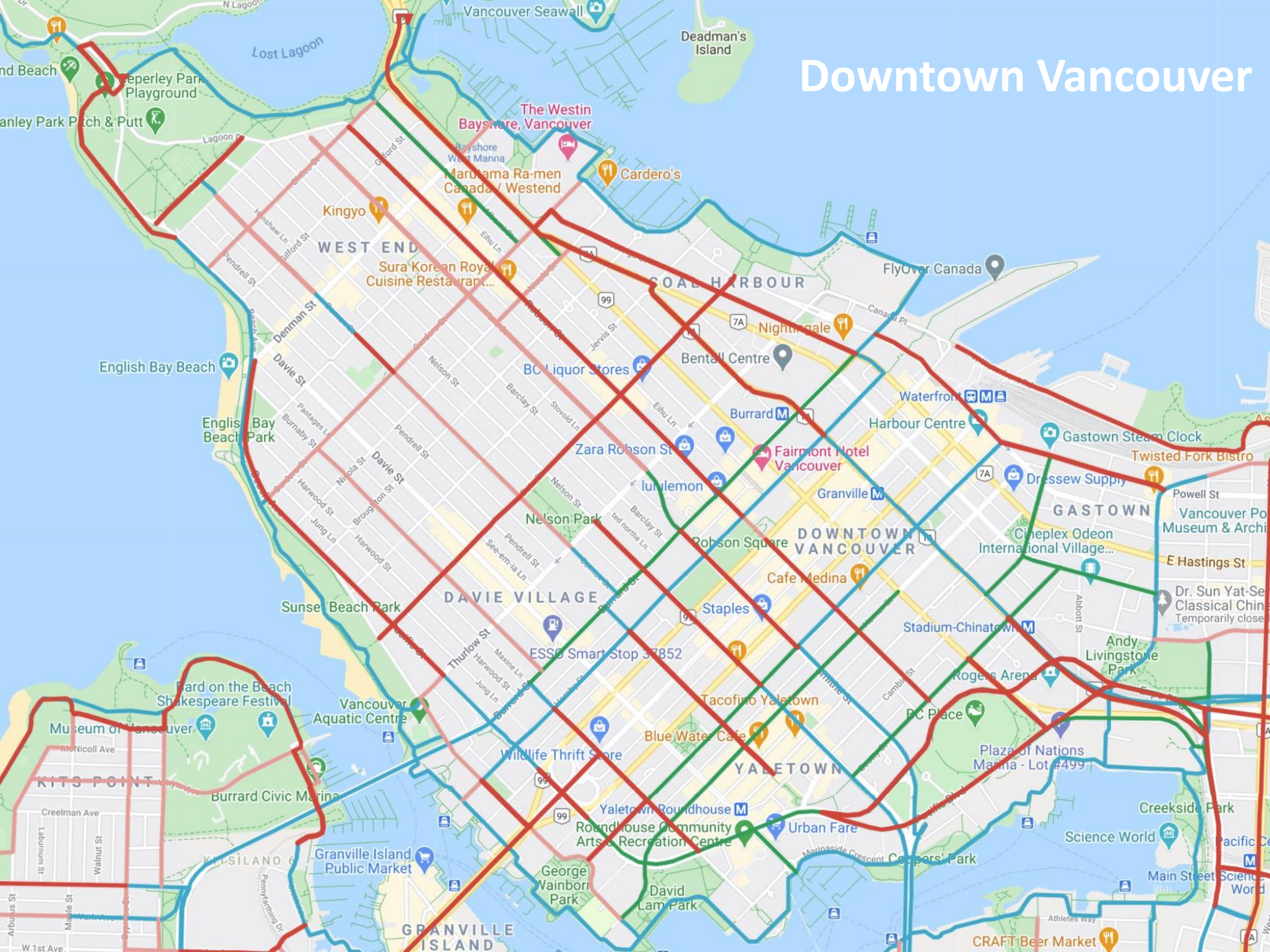

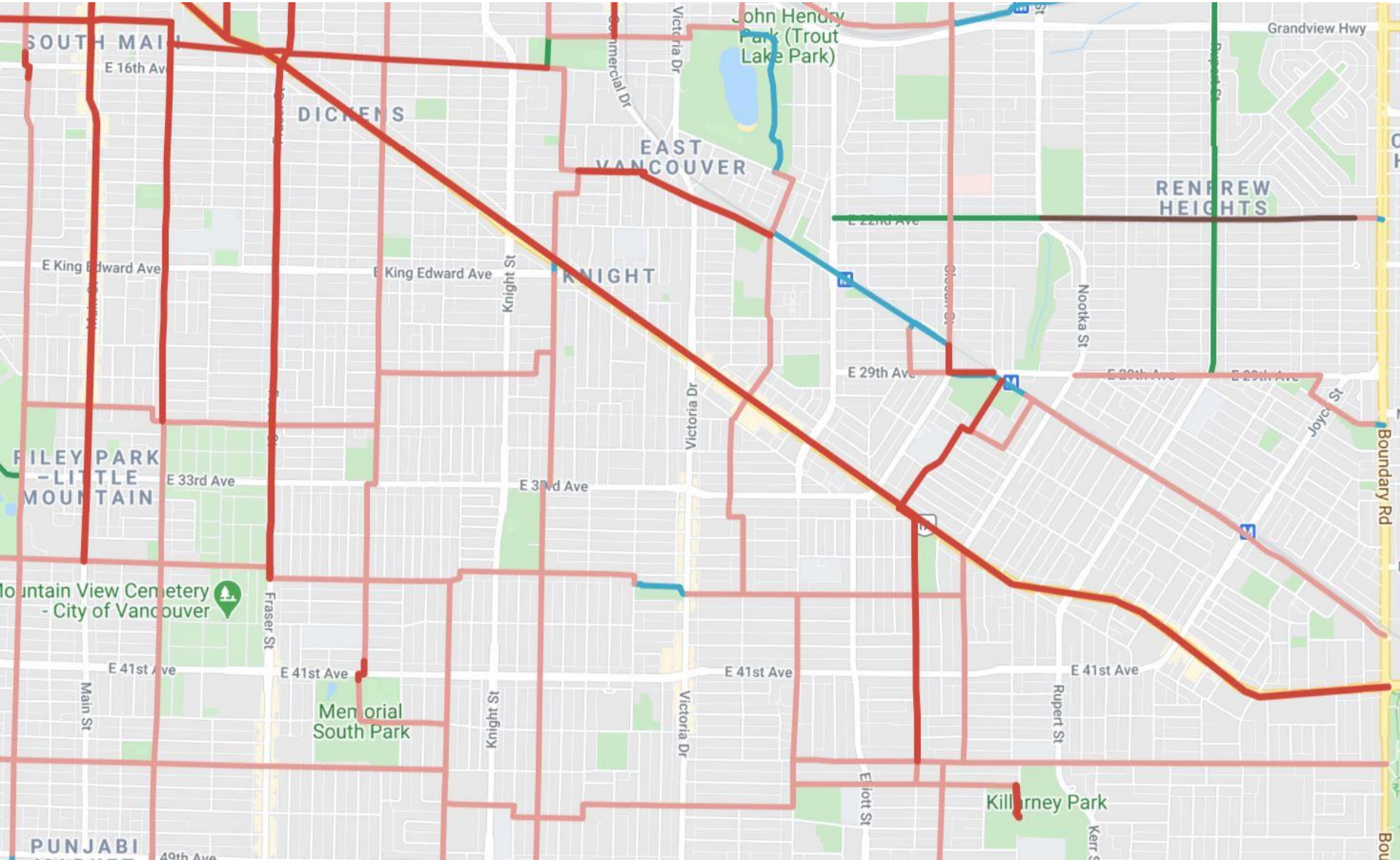

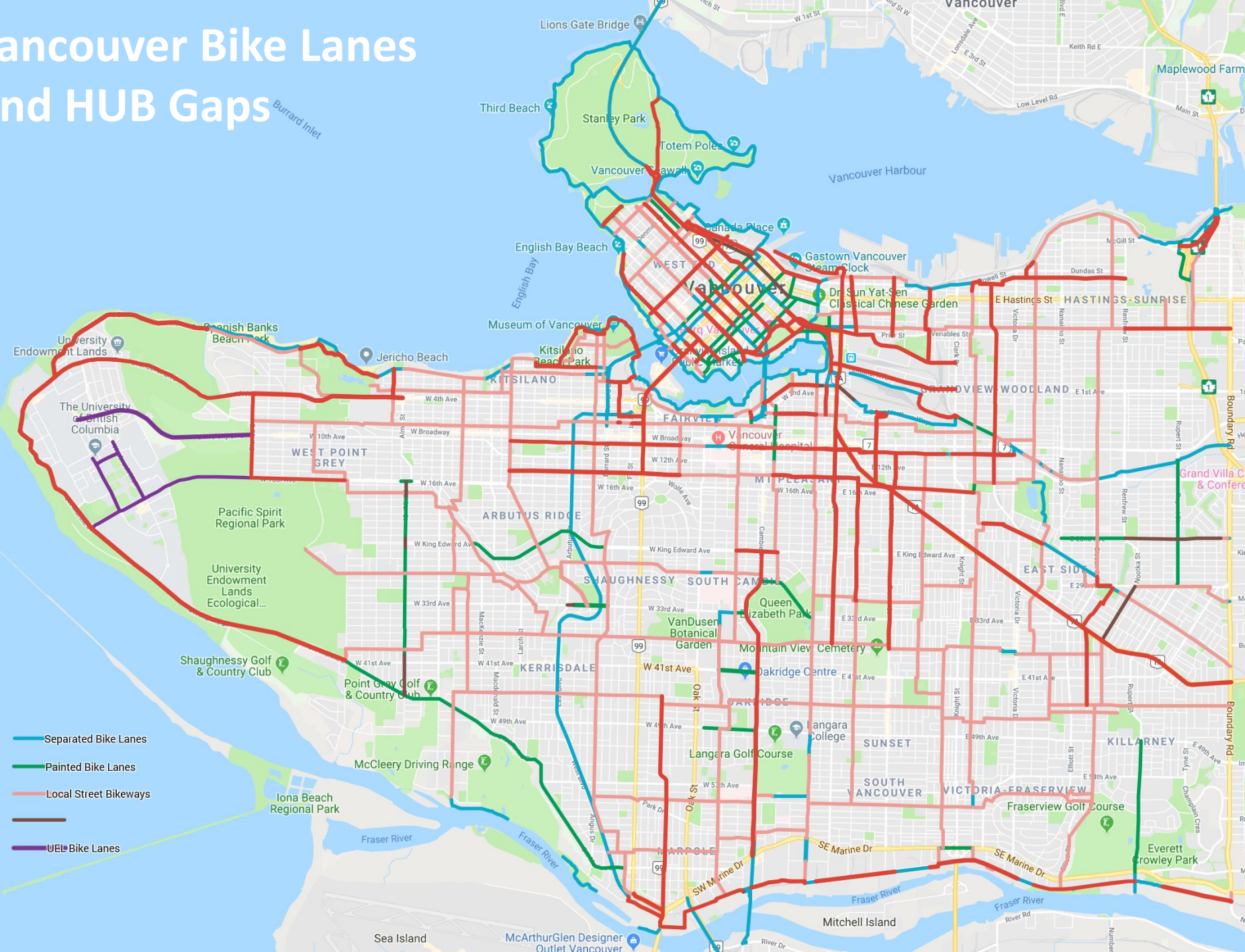
# Vancouver Bike Lanes (Van Map)

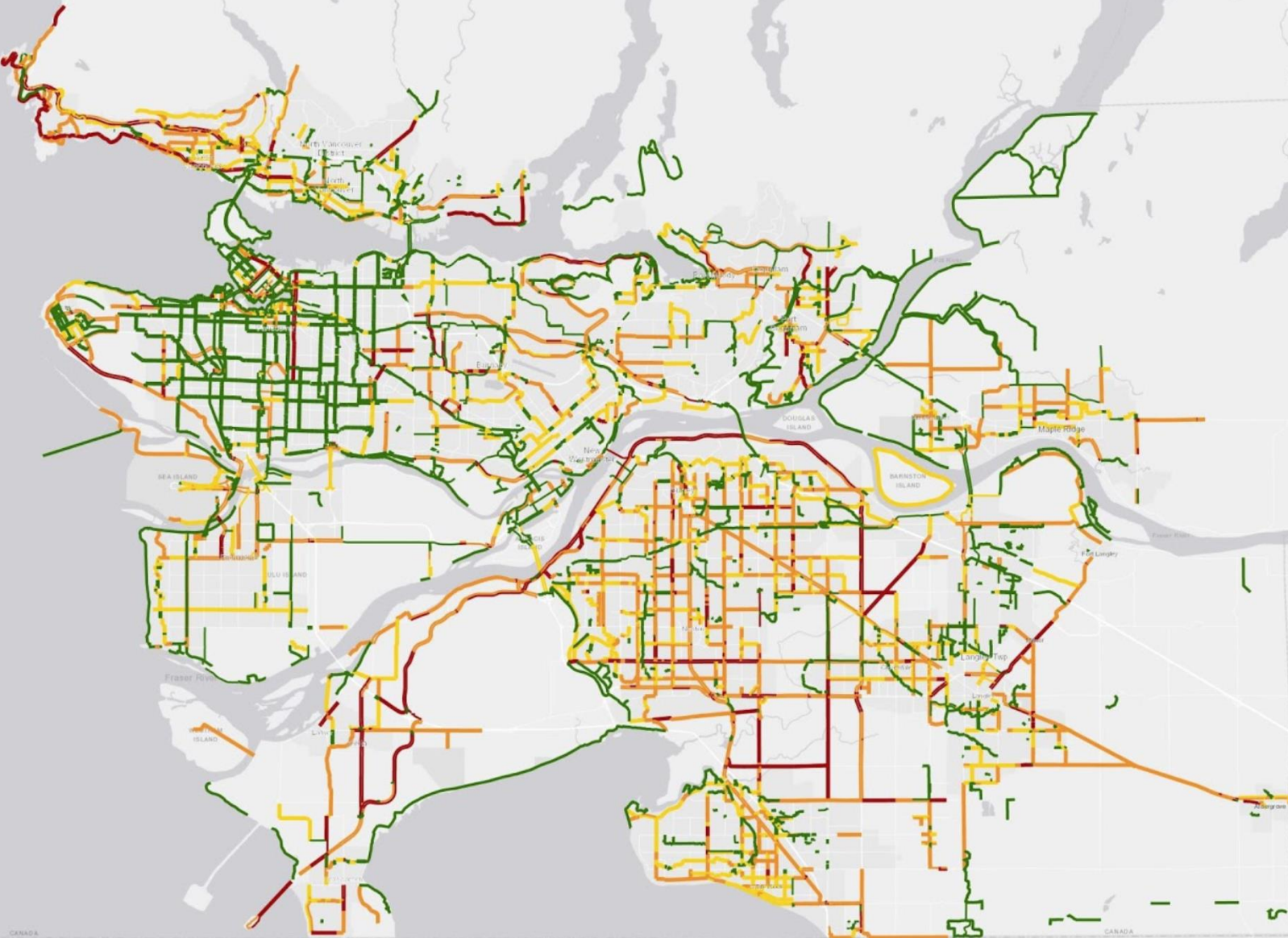
# Vancouver Bike Lanes And HUB Gaps

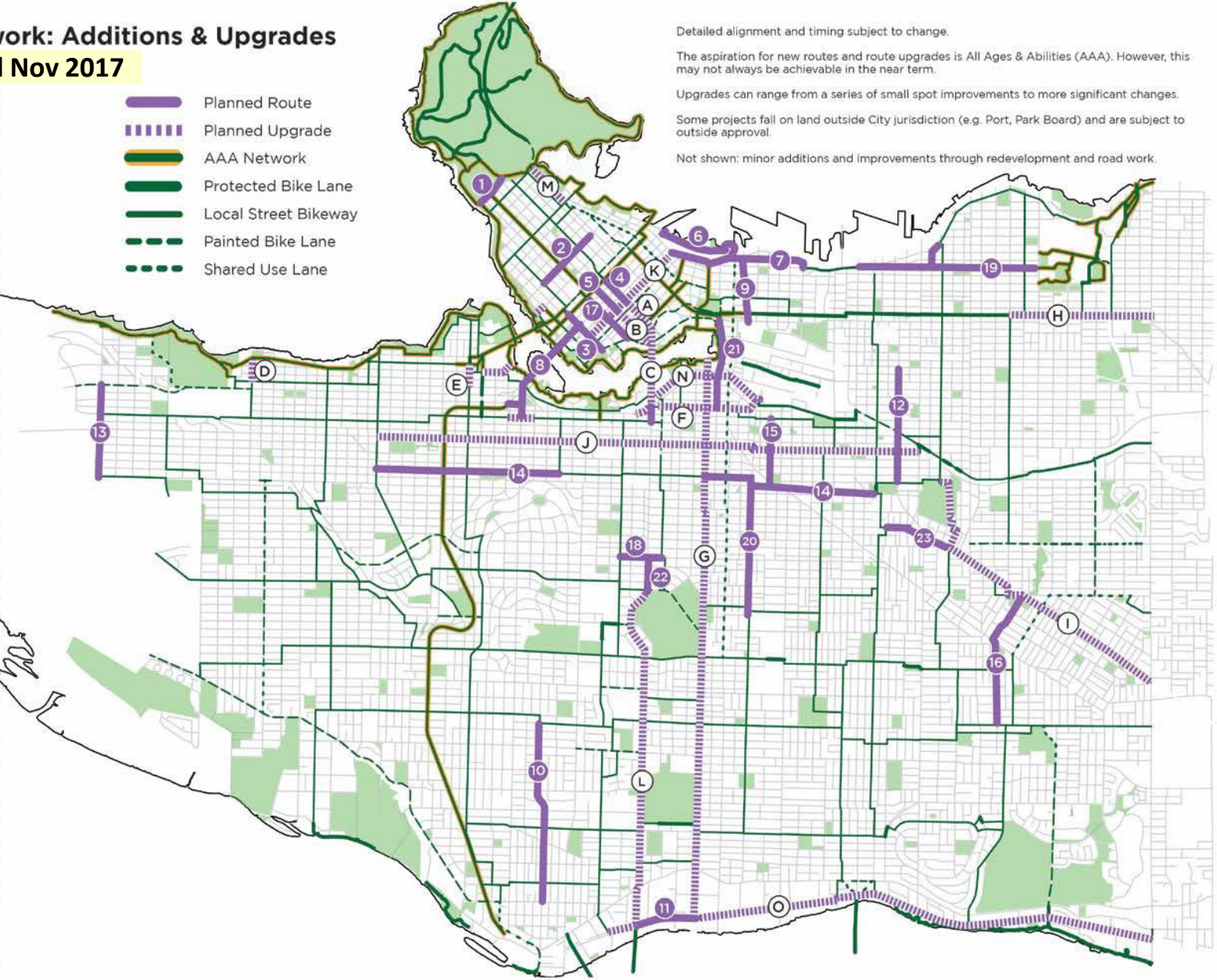

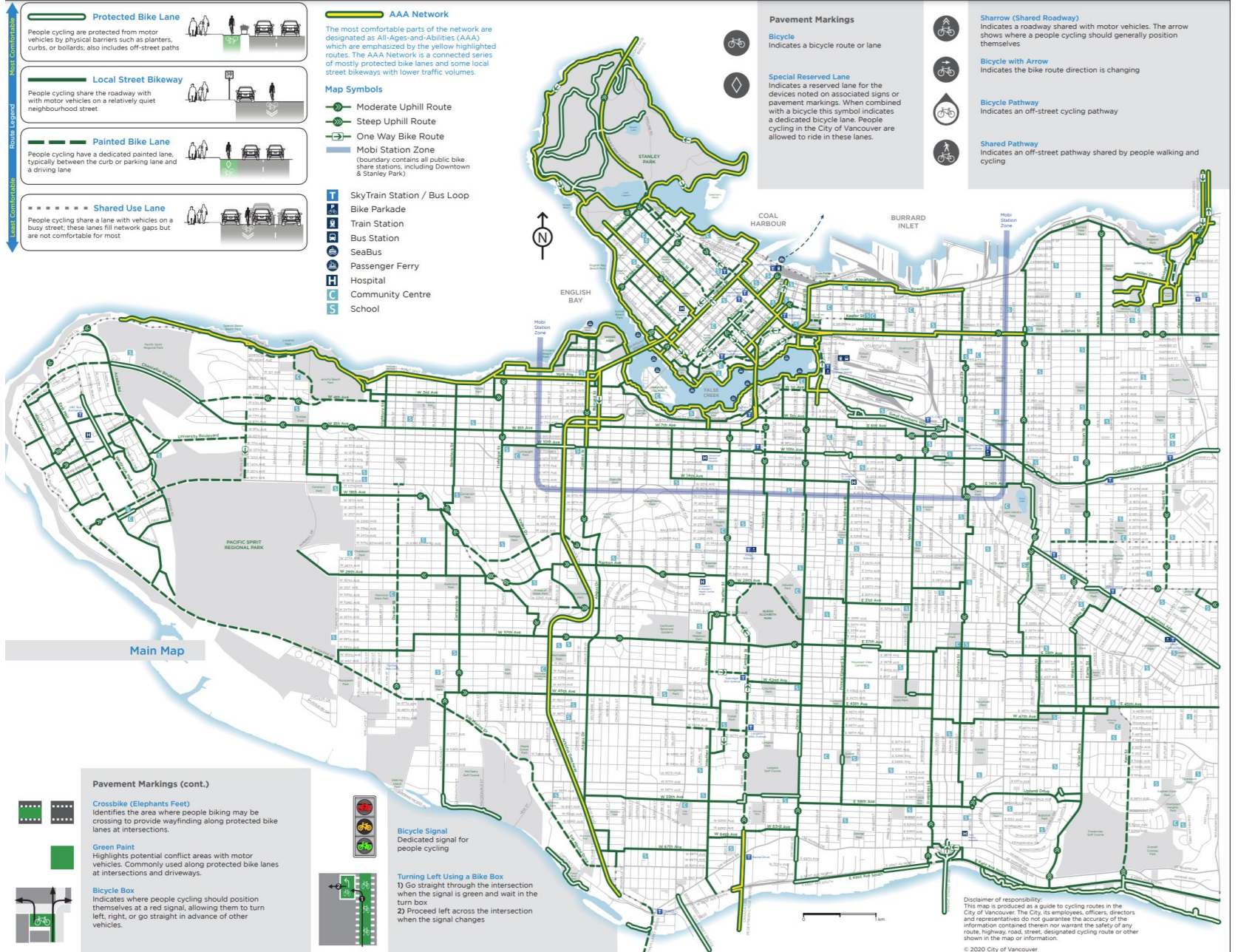

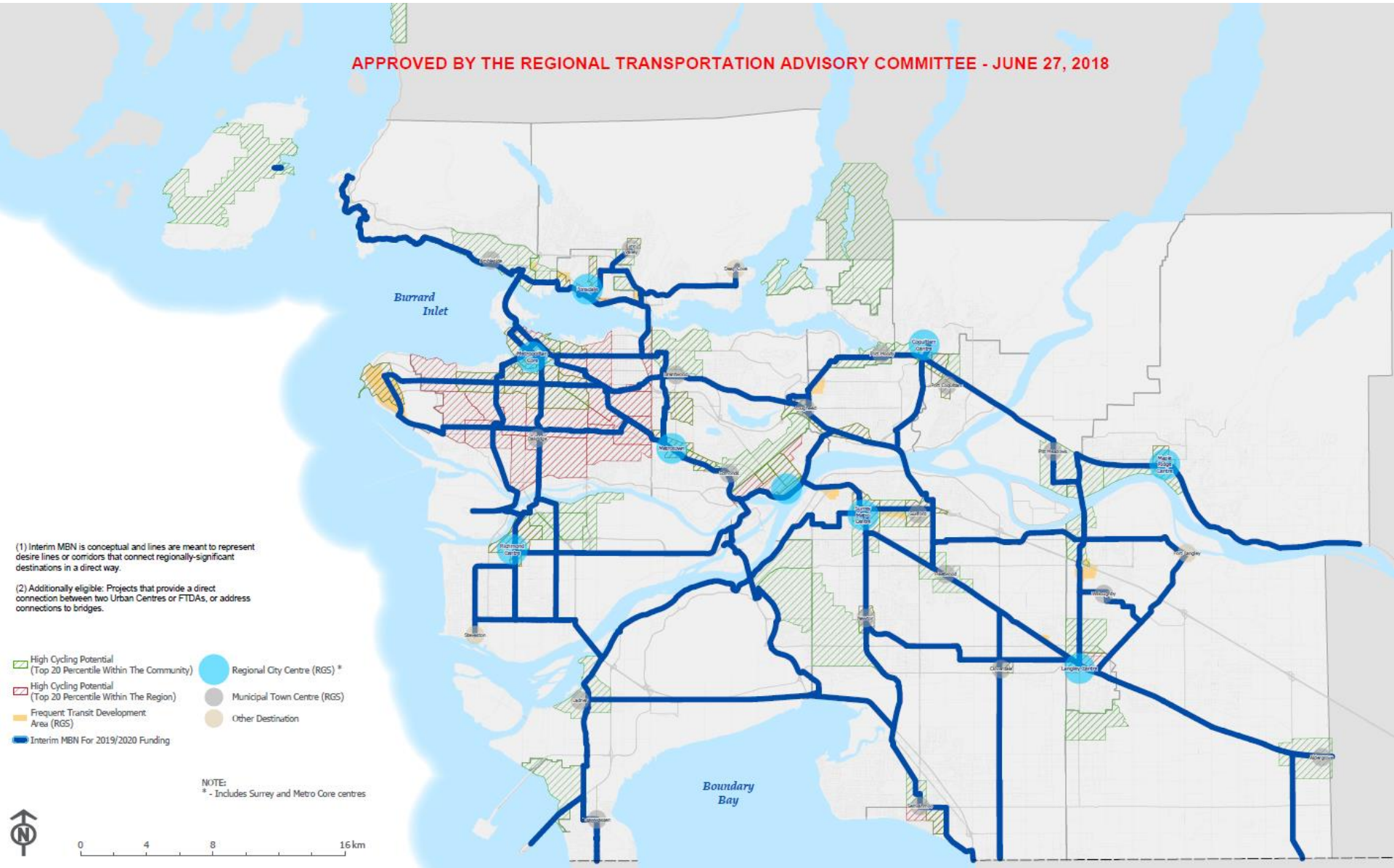
# CoV Cycling Map – Fall 2020 Update





# Translink Major Bikeway Network (MBN)
