- Ken and Peter both gave presentations

#### **c) South of Fraser**

- 152 St street overpass was hit by a semi truck. Overpass is being assessed for possible repair. City of Surrey would like replace 3-5 yr span, MOTI would like a longer time span. Maybe because of the damage the overpass will need to be replaced sooner?

#### **c) King George Parkade**

Security of the parkade is in question after Guy had his bike stolen and there were reports of two other bikes stolen. Translink is in the process of ending leases on all of the lockers.

Both Guy and John were using the bike lockers. John had been using the locker for 12 years problem free. John was using the new parkade and noted that there was Transit police in the parkade and talked to the officer investigating a recent stolen bike.

At a different point John was using the locker and a lady asked him in. She had all of her accessories stolen. This was in the morning. That evening John came back and a parkade user said that his bike was gone.

Last Friday there was a worker that was installing a metal plate to prevent people from manipulating the latch.

#### **152 Street Overpass at Highway 99**

152 St street overpass was hit by a semi truck. Overpass is being assessed for possible

### **150 Street & Fraser Highway development**

Development application to develop property between Fraser Highway and 92 Ave at 150 Street. The development will not provide access from 92 Ave to Fraser Hwy.

Because no access is provided a potential neighbourhood bicycle route will be blocked until further redevelopment. Tim to write a letter to the Planning Department to not support the development until access is provided as the development goes against the cycling plan which aims to develop such routes.

Ken to write letter discussing broader issue of reviewing projects for their benefit to active transportation.

**6. White Rock** - Ken met with Carl Johanson. Discussed Johnston Road climbing lane, recent additions to the cycling network that are too steep for cycling at 18% and moving the routes to better streets. Discussed adding separate bike lanes to 16 Ave west to 136 Street from Martin Street and Roper Ave Greenway
