1. Meeting called to order at 19:00.
2. Welcome and introductions.
3. Minutes of March 2019 adopted.

5. Subdivision and Development Servicing Bylaw - Tony sent in responses from Geraldine/Mitch/Gavin (HUB HQ) to Township engineering about a week after the meeting. Haven't heard back from them yet.
6. 20 in 20 Infrastructure Challenge 2019. Township completed 14 of 20 fixes last year. Andrew from HUB HQ hasn't heard back from either the Township or City of Langley to see if they will be participating in this years challenge. Tony also emailed the City but hasn't received a response. Tammy (Township Engineering) asked Tony for a list of possible fixes before committing (did not send) to the challenge and no official commitment has been made yet.

8. MEC Century Ride May 16. MEC has requested a presence from HUB to take place at the Century Ride from 8 am - 3 pm. Several committee members has expressed an interest to volunteer. Tony inquired about what the committee can offer but hasn't heard back yet.

9. Prospera Gran Fondo July 15 - Coordinator Jen Wolowic has reached out to see if our committee can participate in the Gran Fondo. Tony will follow up with what might be involved. They may want volunteers for set up and take down in exchange for potential support.

10. Metro Vancouver Video - Got scrubbed again due to weather. They plan on interviewing Tammy (Township Engineering).

11. Yorkson Creek Middle School Bike Festival - They are planning a date for mid May. Bike helmet fitting is a possible event. They contacted all the bike shops to see what they can provide. They are checking with HUB to see what courses can be offered but unsure of funding sources (Learn 2 Ride or Ride the Road). Tony will see about borrowing a bus for kids to try the bike rack.
