

HUB Recommendations for Lower Lynn Interchanges

- 1. Protected bike lanes with physical barrier to motor vehicle traffic on all major roads that are newly built/rebuilt (Mountain Hwy, Keith, Brooksbank, Fern/Lillooet)
- 2. Protected intersections
- 3. Separation from pedestrians
- 4. Bike highway along
 Highway 1 from
 Mountain Hwy to
 Ironworkers Bridge





Bike Highways

Features:

- Limited intersections
- Grade separation at highway ramps

Benefits:

- Reduce motor vehicle trips and congestion, especially at Ironworkers Bridge
- Link Metro Vancouver Regional Town Centres
- Improve user safety and travel time
- Accommodate e-bike usage growth


Recommendation:

Lower Lynn Interchanges design and Lynn Creek bridge replacement to include separated cycling facilities (bike highway) along Highway 1 from Mountain Hwy to the Ironworkers Memorial Bridge





Proposed #UNGAPTHEMAP for Lower Lynn



- Bike highway parallel to Hwy 1
- Local bike routes



Why Should You Care?

- Your constituents care about transportation
- 10 Year Transport Plan "BC on the Move"
 - Prioritizes investments in cycling infrastructure
- Interchanges project about more than just cars
 - Maximize Ironworkers sidewalk widening investments (\$20M)
- Provincial government commitment to reduce greenhouse gas emissions
- Federal funds on the table...?




The Ask
