Draft Minutes of Meeting via Zoom: Wednesday May 25, 2022

Call to order: 6:35 PM

1. Meeting/Communications

- a) Review of Agenda – Add Braid Industrial Greenway. Approved.
- b) Review of Minutes (April 27, 2022) – Amend the minutes to indicate that it is the City of New Westminster that is struggling with staff shortages. Approved.
- c) Social Media Update – No new developments.

2. Advocacy

- a) Gavin summarized the results of his Bike Friendly Building Assessment of New Westminster Schools, which he rated on the basis of location, bike parking, connections, amenities, support and policies & practices. New Westminster Secondary School was the highest rated. Lord Kelvin Elementary School was the lowest rated due to the absence of bike parking infrastructure, an unsafe cycling route by the school and poor end of trip facilities. Some of the other schools have poor cycling route connections. Andrew Feltham funded the assessment.
- b) Chi gave a presentation on pooni group's proposed designs for the 810 Agnes Street development, which will include bicycle storage on the first floor and a bicycle lobby.
- c) Uptown Active Transportation Improvement Project – Garey has not drafted a letter of support for bike lanes to connect the Crosstown Greenway to the east side of New Westminster Secondary School.
- d) New Pattullo Bridge – No new developments.
- e) City of New Westminster AAA Network Expediting – HUB-NW will participate in the consultation process. Members were tasked with identifying priorities for the program. The group wants safe corridors through construction zones as the program proceeds.
- f) Proposed Development @ 616 – 640 Sixth Street (Waffle House) – This item was set aside for a future meeting due to the lack of time.
- g) BC Parkway Planned Improvements – There was nothing to report; Urban Systems presentation on the improvements has been rescheduled.

h) Braid Industrial Greenway – The section of the Brunette Fraser Regional Greenway on Braid Street across the railway tracks is nearly complete.

3. Activities

a) Go by Bike Week Spring (May 30 – June 5) – New Westminster Secondary School is unable to host a Go by Bike Week community station. HUB-NW will organize a community station on the BC Parkway by the 22nd Street SkyTrain Station.

4. Next Meeting – Wednesday June 22 at 6:30 pm – The next meeting will be held in person at Moody Park.
