4. **Craig Towers , Yennadon PAC/Yennadon Active School Transport Committee**

Many problems with traffic congestion around schools, some crosswalks are not well lit and parking problems.

Yennadon has received a grant for Active School transportation.

Children need motivation ie. “walk and wheels”, HUB “Bike to School Week”.

September to April is the biggest challenge to getting children on bikes.

One of the barriers to cycling to school is the need for the children to dismount once they get to school and walk on school grounds. He would like to see them continue to bike on school grounds and is hoping to get a cycle track built at school where the children can ride.

Walking School Bus - where volunteers would walk children from Silver Valley to Yennadon.

Jenny asked if they have considered the “School Streets Program”. Craig says they have the future Dogwood loop which could work once it’s built. They could also close off the roundabout to see if that would be positive. Barry didn’t think it could work logistically.

Jenny - how would you like us to support the school? Some ideas:

HUB bike classes - school has to approach the City for permission - they could potentially pay if they can’t get a grant. **Jenny will get Craig information on the HUB Bike classes.**

They could have a fun competition riding up the hill to Silver Valley - who is the fastest in each age group; how many times up in a given period etc.

Bike parade - elaborate on that - our HUB LC would like to get involved in that.

Lobby for separate MUP path on both sides of road.
