  - Planning projects: grants of up to \$50,000 available for successful applicants who wish to undertake planning, design or stakeholder engagement activities. Funding can cover up to 100% of eligible costs.
  - Capital projects: contributions of up to \$50 million are available for capital projects that build new or enhance existing active transportation infrastructure (60% for municipalities; 40% for provinces)
