h. Langley City / Langley Township

Protected cycling lane on Glover from Fraser Highway to Langley Bypass completed. MUPs on east and west sides of 216 from Telegraph Trail to 88 Ave being paved.

- a. Bike to School Week at James Kennedy Elementary School had an average of 80 participants per day. The committee thanks Mitch for running the event the entire week. Prizes were donated by HUB Langley, Caps Cycles, Velocity Cycles and Wespoint Cycles. Mitch completed survey for HUB and will post information/pics about the successful event on FB.

Go By Bike Week - Mitch and Tony set up an information station at the entrance to Langley City Hall June 1 from 11 am to 1:30 pm. There were not many opportunities to connect with locals. Next year we will plan for an information station along the new protected bike lane on Glover.

John, Sarah and Tony hosted an information station in Fort Langley June 4. There were not many cyclists to be found in the normally busy village. It appears that cyclists were drawn to the The Gran Fondo event at Eagle Acres Farm on 240 St.



The committee feels it would be a good idea to have an information station at the event next year.

b. John and Tony attended a meeting with Caliber Projects to discuss a proposed commercial waterfront development in Fort Langley at Glover Rd. The developer was interested in hearing our recommendations for secure end of trip bike parking.

## Recommendations made:

- Outdoor bike racks that allow for multipoint attachment should be installed in high visibility locations.
- o Indoor secure bike parking, drying racks for wet clothes, showers.
- c. Hub Committee to meet with Fort Langley community stakeholders to observe status of current bike parking in the village and to discuss ways to make improvements. June 10 at 9:30.
- d. John contacted Urban Bike Racks in Langley to obtain brochures of the the racks they manufacture. The receptionist advised him that all racks are displayed on website. Prices are only available if a guote is requested.
- e. Change of date for July farmer's Market. New date is July 13.
- f. Questions for municipal mayoral candidates being developed.
- g. John to ask HUB about printing flyers to advertise lifetime membership/volunteer opportunities in local committees. Flyers could be distributed at various events that we attend. John will also inquire about having Committee Members having 'screen share' capabilities during zoom meetings.
- h. Mitch to look into obtaining a municipal map with updated streets so we can plot current cycling infrastructure. The map we have is from 2014.
