Call to Order:

SkyTrain / Fraser Highway

Numerous repairs are being done on Fraser Highway due to SkyTrain extension. Power poles are being changed from one side to the other side of Fraser Highway. Robert put complaint into City of Surrey, BC Hydro and Traffic Management company. Cyclists required to dismount and walk the three blocks in Fleetwood instead of taking the lane. Traffic company indicated that it was unsafe for cyclist to be in a construction zone at 30 KPH according to BC Hydro Traffic Management Plan.

Golf course stretch, the construction was blocking the bike lanes instead of the grass median, cars parked in the bike lane. Safety advisor for traffic was on site to make changes. Alaina talked to traffic control person. Information is in the bylaws about what they are supposed to do around cycling but are not trained. Traffic Safety Management plan is approved.

TransLink Bike Ride

City staff often pointed out that we don't have enough cyclists in the city to warrant infrastructure. If they continue to build infrastructure for cars they will get more.
