# 4. Old Business

**4.1. ATAC PM -** Peter reports as follows:

No October meeting - next meeting will be in November 18. Pitt Meadows will get a \$12,000,000.00 Provincial grant for active transportation. The grant must be used by 2028 and can only be used for the active transportation component of the Harris Road underpass or overpass.

# 5.2. Letter sent to City re Council's Strategic Plan and meeting of November 22.

Maple Ridge Council's Strategic Plant includes the following Key Results: getting funding for east-west AAA cycling infrastructure between 240th Street and West Coast Express Station included in the 5-year budget; 30 secure bike lockers; and add 3 km to cycling network by end of 2025. The projects ("initiatives") listed under the latter were changed according to the Q3 reporting to Council. We asked for clarification in our <u>letter</u>. We will have a meeting with the City either November 28 or 29 to discuss.

# 5.3. Feedback on Translink BICCS funding.

Translink is revamping how they fund AAA cycling infrastructure. They want HUB's view of the infrastructure that has been built. We will send an email to groups.io for input and Jackie, Jenny and Cathy will fill in Translink's form.

All input should be in by November 25.

Ivan has suggested that we should ask Translink if we can work with them directly.
