

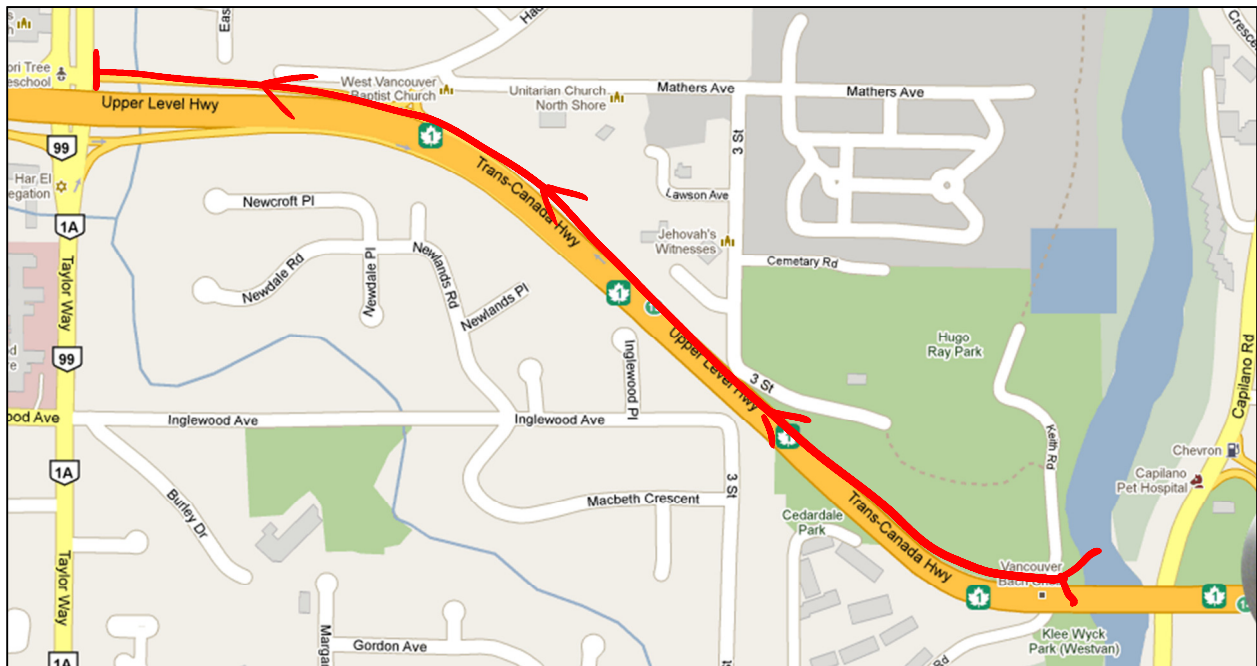
## **Sweeping**

The consensus is that a run down the highway shoulders with a street sweeper every 6 weeks would be ideal. The big culprits are construction vehicles 'shedding' debris on the highway which eventually gets pushed onto the shoulders – our main paths. Also, when there are vehicle accidents, the glass is usually just swept onto the shoulder.

There are some areas along the route that are worse than others:

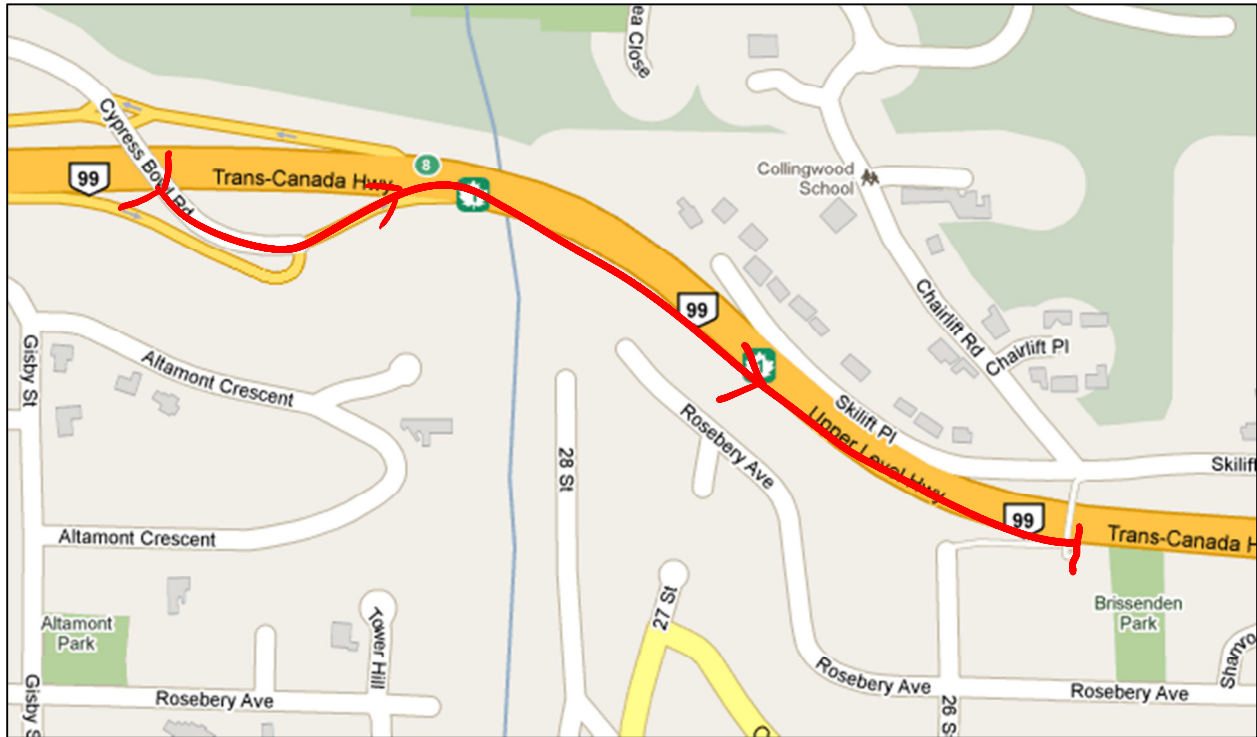
## **Westbound**

> Keith Road overpass to the bottom of the Taylor Way exit (heavy construction vehicles often muster here in the morning and leave debris on the road)



## Eastbound

> Cypress on ramp to the pedestrian overpass at Chairlift Road (the DWV trucks are coming from their works yard and there is always debris)



> 15<sup>th</sup> Street to the Taylor Way off ramp and the on ramp back onto the highway
