- Eimon Yin Westbank Corp.
 - Ironwood Shopping Centre (Westbank's first managed property) is having its 20th Anniversary. Eimon described details about the event (multiple celebrations to take place in a pop-up park in the Ironwood Shopping Centre over the summer).

Those in attendance seemed interested but concerns were raised about the gaps in the cycling network to and from Ironwood Shopping Centre (<u>Gaps 615 and 620</u>).

Bike to Shop Day Guided Ride to Steveston (Sun. June 24) (Cathy & Stephen)

Update (07-03): Nearly 40 people participated in the guided ride and almost 300 people visited the celebration station! Both were one of HUB Cycling's most successful Bike to Shop events to date.

• 20 in 20 Infrastructure Challenge Update (Andrew)

HUB Richmond has teamed up with City of Richmond Staff as part of the 20 in 20 Infrastructure Challenge- a friendly competition encouraging municipalities to complete up to 20 "Quick Fixes" (ex. Repainting a faded bike lane, filling a pothole, etc.) in 20 days or less between July and September 2019.

Joan and Victor from the City have confirmed their participation in the challenge. More details to be discussed at September's meeting.
