Summary

- Introduced activities organized locally by HUB MR/PM to Kathryn Baird, Tourism Coordinator of Maple Ridge Economic Development Office. - HUB will set up a stand at the Bard on the Bandstand play by Emerald Pig Theatrical Society in Pitt Meadows on Jul 20. Barry/Abby, Peter and Ivan/Jackie plan to attend.
- Translink Major Bike Network and 2019 cost sharing program – Barry to contact Dave P of MR engineering regarding this just announced Translink initiative and see if and how HUB MR/PM can assist. Peter and Kino will also add an agenda item to discuss at the next Active Transportation Committee meeting in Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows, respectively.
- Discussion on recent cycling accident and future of Old Dewdney Trunk Rd – Barry communicated with Dave P regarding the recent incident. Old Dewdney Trunk Rd is geographically constrained and not much can be done to enhance cycling safety along that stretch.
- Discussion on no-cycling sign posted on Golden Ears Way westbound at 203rd – Barry contacted Translink who acknowledged that the sign was erected by mistake. A work order will be submitted to have the sign removed.
- Revised HUB questionnaire – Barry has revised the questionnaire, and a soft copy will be sent to the team. This questionnaire will be used at local events to engage residents.
- Maple Ridge bike map – Ian to continue with effort and will discuss further at next meeting.
