4. HUB Richmond Communications (Stephen)

- Lansdowne Redevelopment (VanProp and Pottinger Bird Community Relations)
 - Project plans show a Proposed Master Land Use Plan. This needs to be the 'gem' of Richmond, not Minoru. Looking to have bike storage and bike throughway.
 - Vanprop reached out to HUB Richmond.
 - Stephen attended VanProp offices for a brief discovery meeting and indicated that they must focus on conflict zones and hierarchy
 - Suggestions for design should not have pedestrians and people on bikes in conflict with cars. This would make space for all modes of transportation.
 - CEO and VP Development to attend a future HUB Richmond to present plans and obtain feedback
 - A HUB Richmond subcommittee required to site study and propose recommendations to the Lansdowne Redevelopment project
