### **Active Transportation (AT) Summit**

Robert did several excursions on e-bike to look at New Westminster bike infrastructure and transit bus stop build. The Bird Bike project was a City of Surrey staff initiative. The pilot project was launched in April 2024 and has had 4750 riders. Average usage is 19 minutes for a distance of 2.8 km.
