4. Old Business

4.1. Earth Day, April 23, 2022 - Jenny suggested using white boards to post answers to questions such as:

- Do you feel comfortable on a Multi-use Path as a pedestrian with bikes, e-bikes, e-scooters etc.?
- Do you feel comfortable on a Multi-use Path as a cyclist with pedestrians, e-bikes, e-scooters etc.?; and
- Name one change you would like the City to make in order for you to cycle.

Barry has 15 bikes for different age groups that are clean and ready to go. Jackie has 1 bike that is clean and ready to go and another that is being fixed up. Barry will take the second bike to his shop for later (GETI Fest?).

Discussion with respect to whether a survey should be given to people stopping by the booth. Some think people will not be interested in filling in a survey if it takes too long. Barry said the survey should only take 2 minutes to fill out.

Discussions with respect to how the raffle will work and how cycle/recycle works.

4.2. Bike to School - Jenny suggested we should contact another school besides Yennadon to help them get the children involved in biking to school. She will contact HUB Head Office to find out what is the best way to contact the schools.

Craig Towers of Yennadon PAC will let us know how HUB can support the Bike Parade in either May or June.

4.3. Bikes for Katzie - Rotary Club has issued a cheque for \$1500.00 for a bike repair station at Katzie. Jackie has 11 bikes, Mission Bike Shop has 10 to 12 bikes and Jenny has 1 ladies bike.

4.4. Hub Administration (allowance/expenses) - Allowance of \$400 per year plus \$200.00 for State of Cycling - Total \$600. **Expenses** - rmcyclist.info website hosting (\$405.53 for 3 years - Nov 2021 - Nov 2024) and pizza for 2 meetings in 2021. Total expenses: \$522.36. Balance: \$77.64. Since the remainder of the State of Cycling amount rolls over to the new year we have up to \$477.64 to spend this year.

4.5. Nomination for Co-chair - Ivan nominated Jackie for co-chair. Jackie has accepted.

4.6. 117 Avenue Multi-use path - Discussion regarding safety of MUP on 117 Avenue.
