- Great Blue Heron Way Updates

- Group met with Elder Ruth and rep from Okanagan
- April 29 meeting with Michael Wiebe (Vancouver Council)
 - Great Blue Heron Way will be included in Metro Vancouver 2050 Greenway Plan
- Discussion of gaps: Rice Mill Road & Dyke Road that connect with existing tunnel. Majority of gap is in industrial park so will need negotiating with existing property owners and tenants.
- Leaving it open for munis to decide connections with new tunnel
- Ferguson Road (connection b/w Sea Island and Iona)
 - Airport authority would be involved, would be willing to provide financial assistance
 - Planning on moving the road itself. There will be an off-road AAA bike route along corridor
- Joint bike ride with Delta Local Committee
 - Coordinate with Neil and Roel, but chair is recovering
- Massey Tunnel Updates
 - Sheryl attended open house. Current mockup is 5m wide MUP in the centre of the tunnel, in a separate tunnel.
 - Proposal: overpass or tunnel to be constructed on North and South ends to connect to existing paths
 - Land available on the west side that may be available for other uses on Richmond side
 - West side makes sense, but we need eastbound connections as well
 - 5% grade in tunnel, 3 car lanes and one transit lane on each side
- Westminster Highway MUP
 - City fixed the bike path this past year.
 - Paving job is poor, water pools. Safety concern—in winter we have an ice problem. Contractor will repave most of it.
 - No interim solution during repaving—will need to use the road
 - No timeline we know of, probably not this year
 - 6 to 7 Road: area where bollards have not been installed.
 - Area too narrow, city is looking for another solution. Farm machinery needed to access road and it was too narrow
 - More sharrows being put on neighbourhood roads

5. New/Other Business

- E-scooters pilot now in Richmond (Lime)
 - Trying to get up to 21 stations, mix of e-scooters and bikes. HUB is providing safety lessons throughout the summer because City of Richmond and Lime are concerned about safety. When and where is not decided yet.
 - Scooters are maxed at 12 km/hr for time being, will assess.
 - Lime will be at Go By Bike Week Celebration Station for a demonstration.
