8. Deep Dive: Proposed Gastown Public Spaces Changes (Summer 2024)

- Summer 2024 trial
- Car-lite Water St, car-free Maple Tree Square and Water St Richards->Cambie
- Discussed draft objectives, importance of bi-direction cycling circulation along Water St
- Critical gap in the downtown AT network, including for the Portside Greenway

9. Granville Connector Status Update

- Demolition of north loops complete
- Gravity barriers separating AT lane from motorists mostly in place on west side of bridge
- Work continues, focus on road network at north end
- Signals on bridge to be installed in fall 2024
- Bike-friendly expansion joints installed summer/fall 2024
- Opening of bike lanes late 2024

10. Truck side guards and dangerous right turns

- CoV General Manager of Engineering Services, Lon LaClaire, [reported out](#) about side guards to council on April 19th
- Side guards installed on 20 CoV trucks May 2023, phase 2 (150 trucks) 2025-2026, phase 3 (350 trucks) 2027-2030
- Phase 3 to include contracted vehicles
- CoV General Manager of Engineering Services, Lon LaClaire, [reported out](#) dangerous right turns to council on November 3rd
- Included details about 2021 Canadian study on effectiveness of various measures to improve safety for people on bikes at right turn intersections
- Vancouver-focused part of study noted protected phase at Quebec/2nd significantly reduced conflict, flashing LED “yield to bicycles” sign at Pacific/Howe helped but needs to detect people on bikes better, slow turn wedges and reflective pavement markings didn’t help, “modest safety benefits were observed when installing signage and paint alone”
- Commits city to doing better for new builds, monitoring existing intersections, taking action as necessary

11. HUB Advocacy 101 Workshop

- On January 8th, HUB staff ran a workshop focused on effective advocacy
- Guest speakers: Tony Valente (CNV councilor), Paul Krueger (CoV Sr Transportation Planner), Mike Tancredi (Skaters of North Shore)
- Anthony presented a [case study](#) on behalf of VULC

12. Bike Theft Prevention

- Discussion about bike theft prevention
- Bike theft prevention is one of our [guiding principles](#)
- Potential reestablishment of VULC Bike Theft Working Group

13. Consultations

- No current public engagements; expect Gastown Public Spaces, Portside Greenway, Broadway Public Realm, East Park to come in early 2024
- Discussion about Jericho Lands Policy Statement coming to council Jan 24th. **Jeff and Anthony will write a letter in support of active transportation measures**

14. Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) Update

- BC Ferries Charting the Course public engagement is underway. RAC members will attend a workshop with BC Ferries.
- Ongoing discussions with MOTI about new Motor Vehicle Act, including a focus on passing distances
- MOTI have created an Active Travel Executive Team to raise the profile of Active Transportation

15. HUB Board Update

- Erin O'Melinn departed from the Executive Director role in October 2023. Erin provided outstanding leadership through a period of significant growth for HUB Cycling. Erin has taken on a new role at Translink.
- After a comprehensive search, the Board appointed Laura Jane to the position of Executive Director, effective January 1st 2024
