8. Deep Dive: Making the Case for Cycle Highways in Metro Vancouver

- HUB Cycling research staff have completed and published a report. It is being used in discussions with multiple BC Government agencies and ministries, as well as with Translink and various municipalities. Highlights of the report were discussed. More details in the meeting presentation. The issue of connectivity to UBC was discussed in the meeting. The report does not prescribe certain routes, but instead sets out to advance the discussion. Further follow up is required with MoTI on the connections to UBC. [The full Cycle Highway report can be downloaded here.](#)

9. Consultations

- [Broadway Public Realm](#) public engagement is now live. Our interest is in bike parking, water fountains, accessible public washrooms, permeability through parklets and plazas, and more. Given the lack of dedicated lanes, it will be important for sidewalks to have through zones. More details in the presentation. The survey is available here until October 22.
- [Gastown Public Spaces](#) public engagement is now live. Our interest is in ensuring that the focus is on all forms of active transportation, not just walking. This is an area with multiple cycling routes that are not connected, so we need to close the gaps. More details in the presentation. The survey is available until November 19.
- [Burrard Peninsula Area Transport Plan](#) public engagement is now live. More details in the presentation. The survey is available until October 27.(Translink)
- Portside Greenway Phase 2 Engagement with design concepts is now expected in Q1 2024.
- The CoV [2023-2027 Active Mobility Plan](#) routes and initiatives are now on the City website

10. Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) Update

- MoTI Consultation on proposed changes to regulations to enact the updated Motor Vehicle Act, particularly with respect to following and overtaking distances, and potential penalties for infractions.
- Further MoTI Consultation on widening of Hwy 1 from 264th to Abbotsford, to include Active Transportation infrastructure parallel to Hwy 1
- Mayor's Council [Access for Everyone](#) stakeholder engagement is underway.
