Engineer mention to our rep on Traffic Safety Committee that perhaps city should have transportation engineer dedicated to cycling infrastructure.IV. mayor advised cycling route between lake & freeway (freeway trail) from New Westminster to downtown Vancouver will come in next 5 yrs. He indicated the city has to do better with regard to cycling.
