1. Welcome & Introductions
2. Minutes for February 20, 2024 were taken as approved since there were no comments from attendees after distribution.
3. Old Business
 - a. Langley City update
 - i. Sarah recapped Don Osborne's discussion from January
 - b. Langley Township update
 - i. TOL is going ahead with approval of new bike parking - removing "coathanger" style racks and replacing them with U-shaped locks. Intention is eventually to replace all of them.
 - c. Action plan for 2024
 - i. MUPs - education of staff and councils re their limitations and drawback - Steven to champion
 - ii. Ungap the Map - complete the review and submit to HUB - John and Barry to champion
 - iii. Master Transportation - consultations and feedback to planning process - champion to be identified
 - iv. Also discussed increasing contacts with engineering staff and council - not part of the official plan, but we will continue working on this over the year
 - d. John and Barry met with Jeff Leigh of Vancouver HUB re Ungap the Map project. The goal is a wish list of our ideal infrastructure in Langley. Will review what they have and bring to committee when they have a draft to submit.

- e. January 8 advocacy workshop - no one from our committee was able to attend but John reviewed the minutes. Best way to advocate is to make connections with the decision makers - i.e. council and senior engineering staff.
4. New Business
 - a. Recapped re letter of support for the 40th Ave. MUP.
 - b. Rider leader training coming up April 6, there is still room to register. (Sarah and Jacob attended.)
 - c. Translink is looking for consultation on a study of bike infrastructure. Jeff Leigh recommended not participating as they are looking for informal routes and HUB prefers to focus on formal designated infrastructure.
 - d. John to meet with COL's Mohammaoud Hassan re Skytrain consultations. Steven or Michael will join. Also want to discuss reorienting bike routes.
 - e. Master Transportation plan - there are multiple opportunities to consult - please attend the open houses and provide feedback to the surveys if you haven't already.
 - f. The committee has a budget of to be spent by the end of March. John will register as a delegate at the Active Transportation Summit June 18, 19 in New Westminster. Steven suggested cards with a QR code linking to the committee information webpage.
 5. Other business
 - a. Family ride coming up on April 1 hosted by the Surrey/White Rock committee. Still room to participate
 - b. Bike valet for the COL has been approved for April 20. They asked us to help, discussed providing volunteers for the day
 - c. Glover Road overpass opens soon - would like to have a bunch of cyclists there when it happens. Possibly a social meet & greet at TWU then ride to the overpass. Jacob will see if he can book something. Opening expected mid-July, no date specified yet.
 - d. August 17 there will be 3 events with bike parking in the COL and TOL - Ribfest in Mcleod Park, a car show at Kwantlen, Art in the City near the one-way.
 - e. HUB is campaigning against right turns on red.
 - f. Executive director of HUB has offered to come for a bike ride with engineers and planners in local municipalities.
