 - Someone to keep track of bike-related items from City Council, report back results
 - Good place to look is the <u>Public Works and Transportation</u>
 <u>Committee</u>
 - Keep track of how council members are voting for cycling-related motions
 - Talking to developers about bike infrastructure
 - Also done by some other local committees (Tri-cities brought a developer into their meeting)
 - Richmond publishes a <u>list of active development proposals</u>, so it'd be good to keep track of that
- Contacting the council/City:
 - Derek has been more involved in the past with contact with the City
 - Joan Caravan (staff at City) was transportation planner but has since retired
 - Donna knows Michael Wolfe (councillor) personally
 - Generally haven't kept up contact with City councillors)
 - 44% of mayors & councillors have endorsed the HUB cycling platform (Chak Au, Alexa Loo, Bill McNulty, Michael Wolfe)
 - Now would be a good chance to reach out, say "hey you supported our platform, great, now let's make it happen"
 - Ask what they plan on putting forth in council
